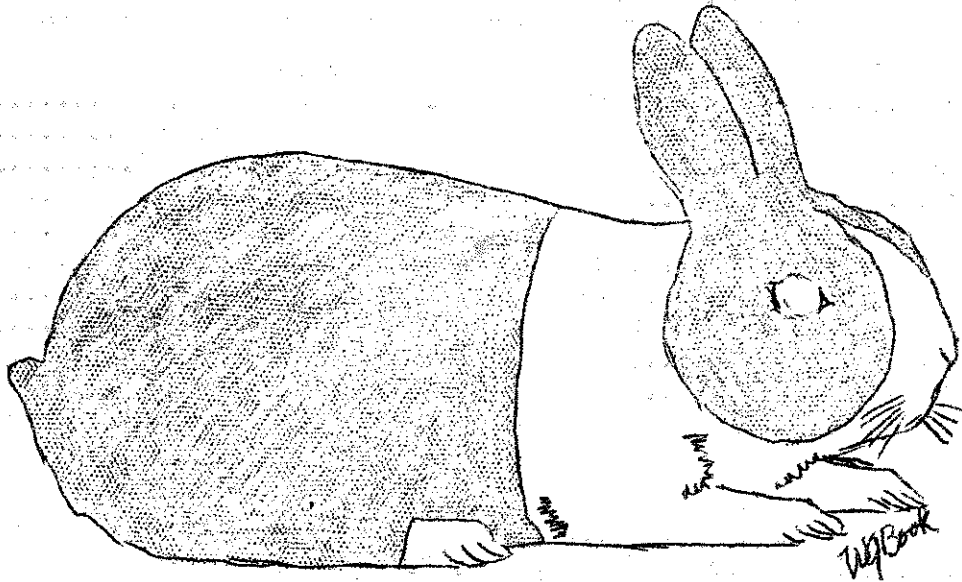

1969 A.R.B.A. Convention

I crossed the line in 69.....

Saturday, Sept. 20th, our neighbor drove us to O'Hare Airport where we took Continental Flight #21 at 9 A.M. that took us to Denver, Colo. We had a very nice breakfast on the plane and arrived at Denver at 10:08 A.M. We checked into Western Airline and had a few minutes to shop at terminal. We came out with a \$1.00 profit? We received 8% on a dollar at Hotel, which we found out was the best place to exchange American for Canadian currency.

Sunday evening was Dutch Board Meeting in our room. Had a nice meeting and took care of all the business. Our new Dutch Guida Book is in the hands of printers, but they are on strike. Hope strike has been settled by now.

Monday at 7 A.M. the Gang had breakfast in Husky Tower. This was quite an experience. Set my white hat on ledge and Ivan Miller almost got it as inside booth area turned around and ledge did not. We started Judging about 9 A.M. A few of the Judges were unable to make it. Other Judges were hired to replace them. Each Judge had his own bay to judge. This meant that I had only four breeds to judge instead of seven. We all judged very close to the same amount. All judging was completed on Monday. A Blue Dutch won BEST IN SHOW. I believe that it was owned by Leonard Weir. YOU CAN'T BEAT THE DUTCH. Monday there were several Speciality Club Banquets and private parties.

Tuesday was reserved for Specialty Club meetings. A few breeds did not have much representation, but the ones that did had very good meetings. I understand that A.C.B.A. (Cavies) will split their Secretary job into three parts. One General Sec'u. one News publisher and one Point Keeper. I think that this is a very good idea and believe other Specialty Clubs may follow this pattern. Several Clubs are getting so big that it is difficult for one person to handle all the details.

Tuesday Evening was A.R.B.A. Banquet and one we ALL enjoyed. The main speaker was EXTRA SUPER and kept us all awake and most of the time laughing or clapping. Yes, we all tried to make Canada green for him..... The 75 or so teen age Choral Group and gave everyone the message, WE WERE WELCOME...I doubt that anyone fell asleep at this Banquet.

Wednesday was meeting of local Presidents and Secretaries. Two bus loads of members went on tour to Banff and Lake Louise. Muriel said that it was beautiful and over 100 people went.

At the Grand Finals for the N.Y.S. circuit held at Henrietta, N.Y. and sponsored by the Rochester Club, a Black and White Dutch owned by J. Richard Cooper, Breesport N.Y. won Best in Show. Show Supt. William Buell had not released the Best of Breeds and each was brought to the judging table to be discussed. Judges, Bob Byrne and Sam Gerardi conferred on the rabbits and they were remarked on, one by one, not in any order. Judge Byrne carefully gave remarks about each one and repeatedly stated that there were some exceptionally good rabbits to choose from. Some of the Best of Breeds were better than the majority of those he had judged in the past. Finally, the choice narrowed to a White Plish, nearly perfect, owned by Frank Pandino and a Black and White Dutch owned by Mr. Cooper. This Senior Doe must have been pretty good. Other entries by Cooper included; Best Blue, Best Opp. Black and Best Black Jr., Best Choc Doe and Best Chocolate. He took a "Best" in every color he entered.

To make the week end more exciting, he was presented with a plaque naming him, "Outstanding Breeder" Wayne County's William Valcore presented four plaques to breeders who had been especially helpful to his club.

This plaque, plus trophies for Best of Breed Dutch and Best in Show and the announcement that he was high point winner (dutch) for state trophy really made for an exciting week-end.
