

President's MESSAGE

his year's ARBA Convention had many happenings, some good, some not so good. The not so good revolves around two of our prominent Dutch members. The week before the Convention, Dick Gehr had a heart attack and had to have major surgery. He missed the Convention. At last report, Dick was at home and doing much better. Then on Tuesday night, I received a phone call at the hotel informing me that Doreen Bengtson had been admitted to the hospital with chest pains. Although she did miss Wednesday of the convention. she was there walking around on Thursday. It was not her heart. You'll be glad to hear that she is doing fine now.

There was also a show at the Convention and it was a good one. Over 600 Dutch went across the open table and over 200 were in the youth. Congratulations to Evenburg and Stearns in the open and Julie Toth in the youth for their Best Dutch awards. Julie also had BOS Dutch in the youth while I had that honor in the open show. The quality looked very good in both the open and the youth.

I was disappointed with a few animals that showed up in the seller's class. A few of these should have never been kept longer than a few weeks, let alone be sold in the seller's class for breeding stock. There were some nice ones in the class, but the few bad ones tarnished the class.

There was much activity in the Board meeting and the General Membership meeting. We are looking to expand on the Sweepstakes contests that we offer. We are planning on the addition of a Rabbit of the Year, and a Breeder of the Year, both based on BOB and BOS winnings, as well as a Variety Sweepstakes contest, and a Quality Points contest. The Quality Points contest would only count the top four point earners show by an exhibitor at each show. We will begin these as soon as we have our Sweepstakes program. The Board approved the purchase of a sweepstakes program and we talked to Evan's Software

who makes the program. He is working to modify the program to meet our needs. These will only be implemented when and if the program has the capabilities. We cannot ask our Sweepstakes person to do more than he is currently.

This leads to another issue. All of the changes to the Constitution and By-Laws passed except for one. That was the amendment that would have allowed the Board to set the fee that we pay the Sweepstakes Chairmen and to allow us to list more than the top twenty in the sweepstakes standings. All of the changes required a two-thirds majority of the votes cast to pass. This amendment fell one vote short. The intent of this amendment was to allow us to pay the Sweepstakes person more as his/her work load increased. Currently, the Sweepstakes person gets paid \$1.00 for each show report that is processed. open and youth. The board voted several years ago ('92?) to pay the chairman for both open and youth. When we began to update the C&B we discovered that this wasn't provided for. It was decided that since we increased the workload on the Sweepstakes person, we would continue to pay him for the youth. The chairman currently processes about 1400 show reports per year. I have yet to figure out why there was opposition to this amendment.

We will begin listing the topics for the next four Dutch Reporter issues in each issue. This is to give you, the members, the chance to see the topic far enough in advance that you can write an article.

The Board has taken an aggressive approach to expanding what is available for the membership. What other ideas might you have? Please communicate them to one of the Board of Directors.





I would ask that if any Dutch breeder remembers anything about cage 17 that morning, to please let me or Bob know. It looks like I will be using locks from now on. What a bummer.

Standards Comments by Kevin Hooper

want to commend Eric Mixdorf for the work that the Standards Committee has done so far. They seem to be looking at all of the factors when considering a revision.

A couple of people who were looking to take their registrar's test this spring came to me for a lesson on Dutch. I gave them a thorough lesson, mentioning that the main emphasis is to be on type. Both of these breeders, who did not raise Dutch, said "That's not how the Standard reads." They were right! We have 17 points on the body type, 25 if you add in the head, ears, and the eyes.

Two prominent breeders at the Convention were talking to me about the point's distribution of markings when I brought up this. Both told me to push for my idea. We know how they should be judged. We raise them with the emphasis on the type first, then markings/color and fur. Yet our Standard reads Markings first, then type. No matter what we would do with our standard, we will produce with emphasis on type first, then markings/color and fur. What if we changed our point distribution to show more balance between type and markings. This would not alter how we raise Dutch, or what a good Dutch is. It would NOT alter how the top Dutch judges — judge the Dutch. It would however, maybe help some of the not so good Dutch judges in their judging of the Dutch. It would help us in eliminating weak lower hindquarters, and it would more closely match how we select a good Dutch (Not to mention that it would start a new breeder off in the right direction).

The idea; reconfigure the point's system as follows.

(Notice the markings maintain their importance to each other except for the neck)





Best wishes to all the Dutch people I have met, and to those I have not met.







THE PET CONNECTION

Well, I am not exactly a youth, nor am I a breeder, but one of my best friends is a Dutch rabbit named Snuggles. I adopted her from a person whose group counseling center was being moved to another location, and Snuggles, the center's pet, was not allowed in the new location. I was a single apartment dweller, no roommate, and though I liked being my own keeper, I was lonely. I love animals of any kind and I wanted one that was small enough to enjoy an apartment and cuddly enough to withstand lots of love! So, on a crisp November day, I brought my new "roommate" home for the first time.

I have never had rabbits before and did not know what to expect. Though Snuggles was potty trained (and that helped), I was not used to her rabbit ways. Many of her mannerisms, thumping and incessant chewing puzzled me to annoyance. Plus she was not cuddly AT ALL. She ran from me whenever I wanted to pick her up, fought being held and scratched the heck out of my arms and legs. I was almost ready to give up and give her back to her previous owner. However, my parents started sending me all kinds of literature on rabbits and rabbit behavior and how to make your pet a companion rabbit. I used trust-building exercises, acceptance of her eccentricities and lots of patience. I read and practiced everything I learned on Snuggles and after about four months, I was most definitely her "mama."

To make a long story short, this bunny follows me around the apartment wherever I go, recognizes her name with a cock of her ear, and recognizes the sound of my key in the door lock, always waiting expectantly in the top tier of her cage for me to love and feed her. Her only preferred way of being held is to be cradled, sometimes going into a "bunny trance" — head tipped back, mouth open, eyes' half-shut, paws limp. Many times she allows herself to be carried around like a sack of potatoes, or up by my shoulder, her head on my shoulder and her little feet dangling loosely. For about seven days, the doe had no water, yet she raised the little blue buck and his brother.

MINUTES OF THE AMERICAN DUTCH RABBIT CLUB BOARD MEETING OCTOBER 26, 1997

President Kevin Hooper called the ADRC Board meeting to order at about 7:15 PM at the Fairfield Inn meeting room, Madison, Wisconsin. Answering roll call were: President Hooper, Vice President MacKinnon, Secretary-Treasurer Bengtson, District One Directors — Uran & Preede, District Two Director Billups, District Three Director Carlton. Absent members were: District One Director Peters, District Two Directors Gehr and Mixdorf, and District Three Directors Schettler & Parmer. (Note* Director Mixdorf arrived after roll call.) Also in attendance were members of the Kansas State Dutch Club, Jack Colborn & Alan Kennedy.

The Kansas State Dutch Club presented a detailed report of the preparations for the 1998 National Dutch Show to be held in Hutchinson, Kansas. The report was very detailed and complete. After the positive response from the ADRC Board, the Kansas State Dutch Club representatives were thanked and excused.

A motion made by Wayne MacKinnon, seconded by Rick Billups to dispense with the reading of the minutes of the last board meeting because they have been printed in the Dutch Reporter was carried.

REPORTS OF OFFICERS

Wenton Carlton reported that Dutch in his area are rebounding with several new breeders in the area. Show numbers are starting to rise and competition is good.

Martin Preede noted some new breeders in the Northeast. Some "old" breeders have moved on and with special shows and renewed interest it may be time to activate the Eastern Dutch Rabbit Club.

Todd Uran said that youth exhibitors are showing consistently in the states of Ohio, Michigan and Indiana with some high quality animals.

Rick Billups reported interest in a State Dutch Club in Louisiana. It is their desire to host a National Dutch Show in two or three years. Also there is the possibility of a regional Dutch Club in the Washington DC area.

Wayne MacKinnon noted that the Eastern New England Dutch Club is not faring too well. However, Wayne says there is lots of good news in the area with very large showings of Dutch and many excited breeders.

Doreen Bengtson reported the club in healthy standing. Membership is stable and the treasury is showing a slow steady growth.

Sharon Mixdorf said that her district is still on top, however youth exhibitors are down because they are switching to exhibiting in open classes. The Iowa Dutch Club is sponsoring their own Dutch Sweepstakes.

Fran Schettler, although unable to attend the meeting and convention sent a report to each of the officers indicating that there are some changes in California in that breeders in the southern parts of the state are becoming more scare.

REPORTS OF COMMITTEES:

Youth - Since the youth representative is not presently active, Pres. Hooper offered the name of Alan Kennedy as a new youth representative. A motion by Todd Uran, seconded by Martin Preede to approve that appointment was carried.

Publicity & Promotion - Rick Billups reported lots of "out of stock" items because their supplier unexpectedly went out of business. A motion by Wenton Carlton, seconded by Sharon Mixdorf to accept the report was passed.

Standards - Eric Mixdorf, chairman of the standards committee presented a detailed report of activities and thoughts of committee members, along with the input from the ARBA Standards Committee. A motion made by Todd Uran, seconded by Wayne MacKinnon to accept the standards committee report was passed.

Election - The election committee report was presented by the secretary. All resolutions passed except number 7.

Auditing - Sue Strandwitz, David Graflund & Steve Blythe revued the treasurers' books and reported them in good condition.

Hall of Fame - Wayne MacKinnon reports a need for new nominees. Application blanks were printed in the last Dutch Reporter and national shows are a good time to secure signatures for this honor. It was requested that the Hall of Fame Honoree's be listed in each Dutch Reporter.

Special Awards - Rick Billups and Kevin Hooper reported on the establishment of a quality award. A motion by Wayne MacKinnon, seconded by Wenton Carlton that the ADRC start the quality point awards as soon as possible was passed. There was also discussion about variety points.

Guide Book - Todd Uran reported that it is time to start collecting articles for the new Guidebook. Target date for the next Guidebook is Spring 2000.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

Member Retention - Rick Billups presented the report of his committee on member retention. A survey of members was suggested with no action. The secretary was asked for listed of new members so that directors could contact new members. It was agreed that since the secretary regularly emails the membership action to the sweepstakes department, it would be no extra work to include the directors in each message. When each director presents their email address to the secretary it will be done.

1999 National Dutch Show reports that the building has been secured in Oshkosh. Judges have been hired and plans are proceeding. The 1999 NDS committee announced that since 1999 is the 70th anniversary of the ADRC, that contacts have been made to celebrate the event with a "Dutch Special" issue of the RABBITS ONLY magazine.

NEW BUSINESS

The appointment of directors to fill upcoming vacancies was presented by President Hooper. Appointed as District 3 Director: Briony Barnes, Kansas. Appointed as District 2 Director: Troy Ihrke, Minnesota. Appointed as Vice-President: Roger Guetschow, Wisconsin.

A motion made by Wenton Carlton, seconded by Sharon Mixdorf to accept the appointments was carried. After a discussion of the National Dutch Show Rules, there was no action.

The Dutch Reporter was discussed and it was decided to start collecting topics for each issue. This would be done at the membership meeting.

Rewards for membership longevity was discussed and a motion by Martin Preede, seconded by Rick Billups that the secretary pursue the establishment of recognition of long-standing members in 5 year increments was passed. Special Awards were discussed again and a motion by Wayne MacKinnon, seconded by Rick Billups that the ADRC look into purchasing a program that will help the sweepstakes counter do his tasks was passed, with the stipulation that the sweepstakes counter be consulted as to the need and desirability of it.

A last special award was presented by the Publicity Department. After discussions, Wayne MacKinnon made a motion, seconded by Wenton Carlton that the ADRC Publicity Committee can use the funds from the Convention and ND raffles to build a fund of \$1000 to be offered for any DUTCH winning OPEN BEST IN SHOW at an ARBA National Convention and \$500 for any DUTCH winning YOUTH BEST IN SHOW at an ARBA National Convention. The motion passed. The award to begin being offered at the ARBA National Convention in 1998.

A motion made by Wenton Carlton, seconded by Rick Billups that the meeting be adjourned was carried. The meeting was adjourned.



97 ARBA CONVENTION OPEN JUDGE'S COMMENTS

ello Dutch Breeders, What a pleasure it was to be able to judge so many good Dutch rabbits in Madison, Wisconsin at the ARBA Convention and Show. The following are a few observations about the Dutch and their colors.

Overall I would say that the type is becoming more consistent whether they are the 3 1/2 lb. or the 5 1/2 lb. Dutch. The better balanced Dutch shows the markings off to its advantage.

The Black and Blue colors are very strong and show not only excellent surface color but very good depth of color.

The Chocolate is beginning to show better surface color again, but lacks depth of color. We need to work on this. Remember Jack's Bunnies, Carl Decker and Wilbur Williamson. These breeders chocolate Dutch color carried all the way down the hair shaft. This should be the goal of the Chocolate Dutch breeders.

I believe the Steel color is looking much better, but there are still a few too brassy to be the color the standard is calling for.

The Brown Grays are getting a little better, but several have too much color on the belly. Once this is gone, I feel the top color will improve. We must still decide if we want wide or narrow bands on the ring color. There has to be a happy medium reached by the standards committee so the breeders and judges can be consistent.

The Tortoise color is my favorite color as a breeder. Most of those I judged in Madison were too dark. Once most of the better colored juniors become seniors they are too dark. Keep the blacks and blues away from the Torts and CULL wisely. You will then get the best Tort color. NO OTHER COLOR IS NEEDED IN THE TORTOISE COLOR.


One last item of interest. Registered rabbits, by ARBA rules, are to be OVER 6 months of age. A registered rabbit was found in the JUNIOR class. WHY?


Keep up the good work on the colors. I may have the good fortune to judge the Dutch again in the near future. Thanks for the opportunity in Madison in 1997.

It is not just because we love that little rabbit. It is because of the closeness we feel for each other and the support that is given when times are tough.

I want to personally thank outgoing Vice President Wayne MacKinnon. From the very beginning of my taking over the editor's job, he was very encouraging. I have come to regard him as one of the nicest guys in this hobby, always striving for the good of the club and always willing to help out the youth. He will continue to chair the Hall of Fame committee.

I enjoyed seeing so many of you in Madison. What a great show it was. Thanks to Roger and Sue for their many hours of work as breed chairpersons. We especially had a very nice evening, at Roger's house as we watched the Green Bay Packers beat the New England Patriots (and there were a few eastern Dutch breeders there)! They took it rather well (the loose). And the Dutch booth, looked extremely nice. Rick and Julie continue to do an excellent job and have much enthusiasm for the publicity department. The Dutch club should be proud, to have one of their new director's win the tittle of 1997 ARBA Queen. Congratulations Briony Barnes of Kansas. Way to Go!— to Julie Toth on winning BOB/BOS in youth and then winning her group in the BIS competition. Doreen gave us all a scare, as she ended up in the hospital Tuesday night. Much of the reason the ADRC is doing so well these days can be directly attributed to her hard work and diligence.

Speaking of Kansas — make your reservations now and get your ads and money in. I hope many of you are planning to go and support the Kansas Club as they present the 1998 National Dutch Show.

In closing, I truly wish all of you Happy New Year. Enjoy your rabbits and strive for each litter to be a little bit better than the last.

Again, thanks for all the hugs and well wishes. They have fit me like a warm coat on some days that I really didn't think I could or would survive. Sometimes struggles are exactly what we need in our life. If we were to go through our life without any obstacles, we would be crippled. We would not be as strong as we could have been. Give every opportunity a chance, leave no room for regrets.


