

I have been raising Dutch for about 45 years now (I'm 39 and holding) I still think of the in our history when the time powers that were saw fit to dispense with the AOC's. I began to realize that the one color that we should have kept was what was called a Blue Grey. I that would had several consistently take their share of BOB's. When we lost this color our Steels went down the tube and then again the powers that were renamed this color Steel Grey to account for the straw color. At this time the Grey's or Gray's had a white belly surface color, the undercut being defined by the undercolor. If I knew then what I know now I would still have the Blue Grey's in the Dutch herd. You would then see some decent Steels. This time of development was a classic example of changing the Standard to what we had and not to what our goal was. The same thing could happen with our Dutch type. A Dwarf is a Dwarf and a Dutch is a Dutch.

In thinking of color mixing and Al is right. Blue does not enhance Black but rather vice versa. One has to be careful tho that you don't bring along the blue eye in your blacks in case you are tempted to save a good marked black out of blues. You don't buy good Dutch you raise them in order to know your bloodlines, unless you are just interested in showing and that is another category.

One thing that I have discovered is that Tortoise will enhance Black. Here again you do not keep Tortoise out of Blacks, but rather breed Torts to Torts for good color, but a black with Tort blood will deepen the black color.

One thing I do require with my Dutch is good production, 6 to 8 Here again litter. proper Dutch type will help. I could care less if I sell a rabbit as I like to keep the good ones and the rest go to the I have one buck in the table. barn now that is the "spitting" image of Seeman's AL 27 a buck that I bought at one of our shows years Convention Dutch ago. They do come back to us once in awhile.

had recently I have an interesting telephone conversation with a lady from California. Helena was calling me to inquire about the Dutch had rabbits Ι sell. to Unfortunately, I didn't have a rabbit for her. She wanted a Black show quality buck. specializing in Torts. She asked if I could direct her to a breeder that would be honest in dealing with her. She said she was new to Dutch rabbits. I told her I'd have to think on that for a while, and that I'd get back to her.

We, (my husband, daughter, and I), don't show outside of Michigan very much, so we don't get a chance to meet breeders from other states. However, when I was buying my foundation stock, I did travel to Ohio where I met Jack Wireman. He was the most helpful and honest person I've yet dealt with in Dutch rabbits. Where others took advantage of my ignorance, Jack told me truth! He showed me several rabbits that he had for sale. He went over each one's good points and faults. Then he told me why they were faults. I learned more from Jack in one brief meeting than I had from any other Dutch breeder thus far.

This man impressed me so much that I am working to build a reputation on absolute honesty. I thought I would start this hobby as I meant to go on. I sell guananteed stock and I go over each rabbit with the customer just as Jack did with me. Sales have been increasing steadily, and I think this policy is the reason, along with good rabbits of course. This past year my Torts have won B.O.V. many times.

Now, about Helena, I sent her a recent copy of the DR magazine along with Jack's address and phone number. I told her that if he didn't have a rabbit for her, he might know of a breeder near her that she could trust.

I'm hoping that we will soon have another Dutch breeder building a business on honesty. I wish there were more Dutch breeders willing to help a beginner, and fewer eager to take advantage of them. If I have rabbits that have faults I wouldn't want to buy, then that rabbit goes into the freezer!




