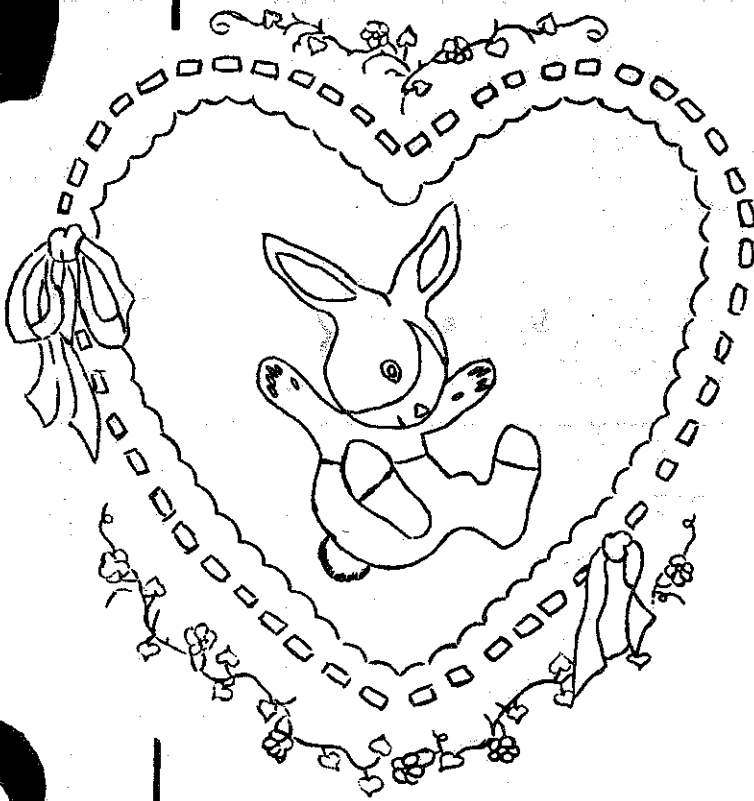

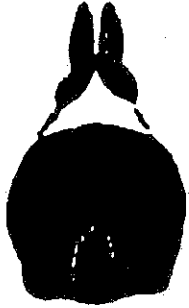

If you have encountered a delay in the processing of your membership, sanction application or other correspondence, I would like to take this opportunity to apologize. The American Dutch Rabbit Club has a new computer system and 'ALL' of our membership and sanction files had to be retyped into the new machine. This took a great deal of time! Mail was not processed as quickly as it should have but it had to be put into the old machine and the new one so to ensure that no files were omitted until the complete change over. Again, I'm sorry for any delay that may have caused anyone any inconvenience, but it was totally unavoidable. We're not completely set up and everything isn't the way it's going to stay, but we're getting there.

Our new computer file has space provided for items that our old system did not. You may now write this office and list your ARBA number, your home and work phone numbers, (or two separate phone listings), your rabbitry name if you have one, and you may also list the varieties of Dutch that you raise. This will assist us in helping someone locate possible 'Dutch For Sale' in specific areas of the country. We will then be able to give them a phone number and address to contact. Should you wish any or all of this information on your file, please submit it to me at your convenience. Remember, if you are a judge and haven't been listed as one in the past membership listings found in each March/April issue of the DR, please notify this office. We'll be happy to put an asterisk (\*) by your name.

Remember to look at your

Dutch Reporter label. Each label has your expiration date on it. Renewals are not sent out due to the cost. Keep your membership current so that any accumulated sweepstake points are not lost due to a lapse. Any questions with regard to your sweepstake points should be directed to either the open or youth sweepstake chairperson. You will find their addresses on the officers' listing page just inside the front DR cover. All completed sanction forms are sent directly to them by the show sponsors. Again, remember that very often when an error appears, it is not always the fault of that chairperson. Many times, the show secretary lists the winner(s) incorrectly or you've shown under a name or rabbitry name other than the one listed in our files. Always remember that mistakes are made by each of us and can usually be rectified quickly and with no real problems.

Ohio and the 1991 National Dutch Show is just around the corner....I'm really looking forward to it! I've got a feeling that this show is really going to be up in numbers with alot of quality animals being shown! I know that Ohio group and you can bet that their going to give it all they've got! If you've never had the opportunity to show with these Dutch breeders, you're in for a treat! They'll make you feel right at home. I hope to see many of you there!

The news here in California is **ARBA Convention!** The California Dutch Rabbit Club is actively involved in putting together the open and the youth Dutch breed organization for this show. Joanne Purpus of Leucadia (near San Diego) and myself are acting as breed chairpeople. Kimberly Kuppens is going to act as youth breed chairwoman. Rose Mead is going to act as open breed secretary, Terri Bullis is heading up breed security and area maintenance, Jill Dobson is collecting specials and heading up the coordination of one of the judging tables. Rick Lehmann has been instrumental in organizing the breed hotel and is putting together our breed banquet. He will also be helping Jill out with the judging table coordination. My thanks to all of these dedicated Dutch breeders who are working so hard to make this the best ARBA Convention yet for Dutch breeders.

Some tidbits of info on Convention--Check-in and out is going to be handled by several centralized stations throughout the showroom. Breed tables will not be responsible for this function. However, show secretary responsibilities are being handed out to the breed tables. Sunday night will be a casino night, and I think that something is planned for Saturday night as well. Tuesday night is going to be the main ARBA banquet. Wednesday night is the ARBA youth banquet. Check-in will begin Friday morning and will continue until Sunday evening. Checkout will be Thursday afternoon.

Be sure to make your reservations as soon as possible at the Dutch headquarters hotel. Rooms are going fast, and the hotel is fully booked between the Dutch, the Champagnes, and the Satin clubs. It seems that Southern California breeders are already getting prepared for ARBA Convention. A recent Sun Valley Dutch Fanciers specialty show had an excellent turnout with over 100 Dutch entered. Best of Breed was won by Rick Lehmann with a black junior doe. Best Opposite of Breed was won by Joanne Purpus with a black senior buck.

Northern California shows have been seeing 75 - 80 Dutch, and the last couple of shows have had almost all seniors! Apparently, only a few breeders are breeding year around here. However, several people have commented that they were going home to start breeding for Convention!

Speaking of shows, the latest trend here in California is the group specialty show. Many all breed clubs have folded, so several specialty clubs, including the California Dutch Rabbit Club, have been grouping together, sharing judges, and holding single or double specialty shows. CDRC participated in the first of these last October, and has been invited to participate in the two being held in May and September this year. These will be held in Vallejo, and there will be several other breeds participating as well. The Sun Valley Dutch Fanciers report that they have several specialty shows scheduled in 1991 and I have seen indications of several specialty shows being held by the Roadrunner Dutch Club as well.

The other important California news is drought--drought! It looks as though the whole state may be put on mandatory water rationing. This will be hard on everyone with rabbits. It appears unlikely that any special exemption will be granted to animal raisers, and we will be granted the same ration of water that other similarly sized families will have. This also means that we will be unable to use water as a method of cooling the barn on hot summer days. We're all praying for rain!

It saddens me that I will be unable to attend, but my thoughts will be there. I am judging in Minnesota that Saturday, and Iowa on Sunday. I know I will be kept up-to-date on all of the happenings though through Norma.

Our show season has started here in the Midwest, but I haven't got a lot of news regarding the Dutch entries. I heard there were quite a few at the Peoria, Il. show, and today there is a show in Galva, Il. I passed it up to get as much typed up for the DR as I could. With my work schedule and judging, spare time is hard to come by. I would have loved to go over to the show and chew-the-fat and show Dutch, but being late last time and having a member raise so much cane about it, I decided I better try to get all I could done.

I have a couple of areas to address that I would like the membership's input on.

First, several people are expressing an interest to change the election procedure for officers and directors. It is contended that it is too hard for people in some areas to acquire the 15 signatures necessary to turn in a petition for office. I do not have real strong feelings either way about this. What are your feelings.

Second, the selection of the NDS judges. Some of the members think the judges should be picked by those in attendance at a NDS prior to the one they would be judging. For example, the judges for the 1993 NDS would be chosen by the General membership present at the 1991 NDS during the Open Membership Meeting. Personally, I

do not like this procedure, but am open minded about listening to any arguments in favor of it.

Third, I am of the assumption that the NDS bids are accepted 1 1/2 to 2 years in advance of the proposed NDS, and voted on 1 1/2 years prior. For example, the proposals for the 1993 NDS could be submitted for consideration starting at the 1991 NDS, and be submitted up to the 1991 ARBA National Convention. Then the 1993 NDS would be awarded by the Board at their meeting at the 1991 ARBA National Convention. I am sure this was decided by the Board quite some time ago, as the sponsoring clubs were having too hard of a time securing the judges voted on by the membership with only 1 years notice. It was felt that by awarding the NDS at the ARBA National Convention 1 1/2 years prior that it would give the clubs a better chance at getting the requested judges.

It sure would be nice receiving a little input on some of these subjects, instead of the same old "empty" mailbox. Seems everyone has a lot to say behind the scenes, and no one has the initiative or gumption to speak up so all can hear them. Guess some people just like complaining while others like to try to correct a situation.

Guess that's about all I have for this time.

Remember, like Jack says, this is your club. If you want something changed, you have to address the situation.

Hope you all have a great show season, and my thoughts will be with you in Ohio.
