


Everyone should be receiving their new guide book before the National Dutch Show. I know everyone will be glad to get it, since we haven't had one in a long time.

Vice-President's

Hello Everyone

1995 was a record year for the large National shows. Kevin Hooper has promised that a new all time record will be set at the Ohio NDS. 1996 could also be a record year for Dutch. Interest on a National level seems to be increasing. The demand for top quality Dutch has been very strong.

One of the best places to acquire good stock will be in Ohio at the NDS, sellers class. Kevin Hooper is setting up s special sale of hand picked quality Dutch to help the American Dutch Rabbit Club survive the 96 fiscal crises.

I will offer a few tips to the newcomers when looking over the sellers class Dutch.

- 1: REJECT any showing these disqualifications-incorrect eye coloring, cow hocked hind legs.
- 2: REJECT any of these faults—white tail coloring on tortoise, severe pinched hindquarters, flatness over hips, roughness over hips, narrow shoulders, flatness over shoulders, notably lacking body depth, thin ears, ears not balanced to body, extremely narrow heads, extremely long fur, long guard hairs, silver tipped guard hairs in blues, lack of ring color in grays, ring color in steels.
- 3: LOOK FOR-smooth hard bodies, fur of the length that enhances markings, fullness in the lower hips, correct width in shoulders, thick set ears rounded at the tips with lots of fur. Dutch that show sharp clean markings. Of particular interest to me would be well rounded cheeks with no hooks or drags. Stops that are straight and even preferably on the shorter side. Also very important to me are Dutch that mature at the following weight, 4 - 5 pounds, with 4 1/2 ideal.
- 4: Consider Dutch 3 8 months of age first, over 12 months last. There are exceptions to age requirements. Make sure breeding records are available on older Dutch.
- 5: LOOK them over good, and ask questions of experienced breeders when in doubt.

I would like to thank Kevin Hooper for the long hours he has been putting in for our club. HE not only did an outstanding job in running the Louisville convention, he was instrumental in working to put this club on the right track in 96. He is chairman of the standards committee, an American Dutch Rabbit Club director, and is instrumental in running the 96 NDS in Ohio. We all owe a debt of gratitude for his unselfish work for our club.

NEWS FROM KEVIN

I was recently reading the original ADRC Dutch Guidebook (or one of the first ones) from 1947. If you thought that nothing has changed in the Dutch since it was imported to the states in the twenties, think again. Here are a few excerpts from that issue.

From the Standard:

Ideal ear length - 3 1/2" DQ for ears over 4" Gray color - with as few black guard hairs as possible. Blueish - Black shading on Torts. Shaded orange portions to show a distinct ring color. DQ for less than 3 lbs.

From the glossary - Agouti, see gray or steel. From the sanction requirements, no one day lawn or table shows! Payback for EVERY BOV - \$1.00 Dues to the ADRC - \$1

Thought these points were interesting. The comments on the Grays and the Torts I found most interesting.

The introduction of the Blue - Steel is at least two years away. Since Tex Thomas didn't receive my application prior to the deadline for presentation at the '95 ARBA Convention, I now must wait the two year period while holding the new Certificate of Development. Then the presentation can begin. By the way, after some extensive homework on genetics, I found that the Blue-Steel will not breed true (Nor will any other steel). At least not if you are going by Dutch genetics. I haven't looked into the Netherland genetics to see how they work. A dwarf breeder who is a friend of Bobbi Shot (sp?) said the Steel Dwarf doesn't either.

I hope you have made plans to attend this years' National Dutch Show. We have some very nice awards and activities planned. One new thing just added, (which was not my idea), is an AOV Class. If you have some other varieties that happen to show up this spring, bring them along. It will be interesting to see the different colors that exist in the non-recognized Dutch world.

This issue contains the proposed changes to the Constitution and By-Laws of the ADRC. One deals with making a permanent increase to the dues, which would replace our temporary surcharge. The other deals with how we ammend our Const. and By-Laws. This change would allow us to make changes when emergency situations arise. The provision would be used only on rare occasions, but would be there if the situation deemed necessary.

Do you have any new ideas that we should be looking into? Write to your Director or bring your ideas to the NDS. New ideas are what we need to keep the interest in the Dutch Club at a high level. I would love to receive my FIRST letter or call from a member who has an idea or an item that needs to be addressed.

Judge Roger Cota has provided me with the following information: Have you, like a number of us, been looking for some serious discussion about rabbits and the ARBA online? Are you considering going for a Registrar's or Judge's license? Are you just interested in learning more about rabbits in general? This is an invitation to join a formal, serious study group 0n-line. We will be meeting on Tuesday evenings at 10:30 PM, Eastern Standard Time (7:30 PM, Pacific Time), in a private room called "ARBAStudy." A number of us have discussed this and set up some basic schedules and formats. You are invited to join us. I volunteered to act as a "facilitator" - I only work to establish a schedule, and have conferred with other members on-line. If you would like to join the discussions, please feel welcome. In order to make this as beneficial as possible. If you have questions on any of the following items, please e-mail me.

We will plan to meet weekly at 10:30 PM, EST, in a private room called "ARBAStudy" on America on Line. Sessions will be scheduled for 1 hour, with an open end for those who wish to continue after that.

For those of you who may not be familiar with the process, here is how you can find us: On the Main Menu, select "People Connection". Next, select the icon in upper left, "List Rooms". Then Select "Private Room". Type in ARBAStudy, and select "OK". You should then find us!

I will attempt to put together a schedule of topics and moderators and publish it monthly. Roger Cota (RACota@aol.com). You can contact Roger or me for the latest schedule of topics.

Item Two: Many clubs or organizations are starting to have pages on the World Wide Web. The dwarf hotot club has one under construction at this moment and should be up and running by the time you read this. Here is a short explanation of what could be used for the American Dutch Rabbit Club in the near future:

A web page is kind of like a digital brochure that can be accessed any where in the world with a web browser. A web browser, such as Netscape or Mosaic, is a program that allows a person to view web pages. Such browsers are already built into services such as America on Line. Web pages are the future of advertising and people even claim the future of television. Most major businesses today such as AT&T, Walmart, etc. have there own web pages as well. A web page can contain pictures, drawings, text, sound, and even video clips. However, most web pages only contain pictures and text. Web pages are written in Hyper Text Markup Language, HTML, which is a computer language that can be read on any make of computer with the proper web browser. Each day, AOL processes more than 14 million hits to the World Wide Web. Once the ADRC homepage is linked to a couple of widely known search engines, millions of people who are interested in rabbits have the ability to read our page from around the world. There are already a few rabbit home pages up and running and one eventually is linked to another.

With the fear of making this column too long, I will conclude it for now and if anyone desires more information or wishes to make comment feel free to contact me.


I'm looking forward to my first show this year and to the NDS in Ohio.

NEWS FROM FRAN

Have you ever noticed how quickly the simplest thing turns into a big problem? Unfortunately, this seems to be what is happening with the ADRC dues.

Clearly, ADRC needs to raise its dues. I haven't heard anyone yet say that the "new and improved" (and more expensive) Dutch Reporter isn't worth the extra cost.

At the ADRC Board meeting in Louisville Sunday night, the subject of the dues increase was brought up for discussion. A motion to increase the dues on a time line other than that specified by the ADRC's By-Laws and constitution was made, discussed and voted on. The motion passed with one dissenting vote (mine), since I felt we could not violate the club By-Laws and constitution for any reason, no matter how good the reason was.

If you read the minutes of that meeting as published in the last DR, you will realize that the motion as published does not exactly say this. I understand a correction to the minutes will be made as soon as possible.

After some discussions at the general meeting Monday, ADRC realized that ARBA would not allow this motion to be enacted without jeopardizing the ADRC charter. Therefore, the surcharge concept was born, I am aware of no formal discussion of this surcharge concept by the Board, and there was no Board vote on this surcharge.

Although this surcharge concept has been approved by the general membership both at Louisville and by mail vote, there is substantial room to question the concept. Is a surcharge the same as a dues increase? It seems to me that, if it is a REQUIREMENT FOR MEMBERSHIP, it is the same as a dues increase. Since the phase-in of this surcharge did require it, I agree with Dick Gehr that a surcharge is the same as a dues increase.

The surcharge has caused a nightmare for our hardworking secretary Doreen Bengtson. After much grief, she is planning on sending out a notice saying the surcharge is NOT mandatory, but that renewing members unable or unwilling to pay the extra amount should send back said notice without paying the surcharge, and Doreen will pay the surcharge out of her secretary's commission. While this is very generous of Doreen, the fact remains that the surcharge is still being paid (which isn't fair to Doreen) and is still required by the ADRC.

While I cannot predict with any certainty where this will all end up, I would not be surprised if ARBA gets into the act and orders the club to stop the surcharge as it is a dues increase.

ADRC certainly could use additional funds for 1996. Maybe you can DONATE \$3.00 per member, or hold a benefit raffle, show or bake sale at your next Dutch event. Anything you can do would help.

There will be an upcoming vote in accordance with the By-Laws and constitution to raise the annual club dues. I strongly encourage everyone to vote FOR this. Club dues haven't been raised for a LONG time and the costs of the DR have gone up dramatically.

I know that my negative vote at the Board meeting and my part in those Monday discussions have caused some people to get upset and criticize me behind my back. I hope that those people will pause and realize that we all want the same thing—the continued success of American Dutch Rabbit Club. Remember what Doc Reed used to say we can disagree without being disagreeable.

One other comment about the ARBA Convention—it seems that one person observing the judging was upset that I was assisting Larry Bengtson at the judging table on Monday. This person's complaint apparently stemmed from the fact that I had rabbits in the show and was also helping. I'd like to point out that almost EVERYONE helping get the judging done on time at this show had rabbits on the table. If these people didn't help, the judging probably wouldn't get done. This situation is not

unique and those of us who are willing to spend our time and effort helping with the show certainly do not identify our rabbits to the judge, if that was this person's concern. Instead of getting upset, why don't YOU help?

KEEP YOUR RABBITS HAPPY!


My name is Julie Toth and I am a freshman at Arroyo Grande High School in California. This is my 7th year in 4-H and my 6th year in the rabbit project. I have had blue, black, tort and brown gray Dutch, as well as a Mini-lop and a Palomino. I share a rabbit enclosure with my twin sister Jennifer, who raises and Mini-lops and English Lops. We are responsible for the upkeep and expense of our own rabbits.

When I first joined rabbits, I went to a local show and talked to some friends of our family who raised gray Dutch. I bought a Junior Doe from them soon afterward and started showing. Then I wanted to start breeding, so I bought a gray buck. I never really had much luck with grays, but when I bought a blue buck and doe I produced some nice blue kits. Then, hoping to keep the blue color deep, I bought a black breeding doe. She produced some very good black kits, so my emphasis shifted from blue to black. I worked real hard on body type. I have produced some "typey" rabbits and when some of the juniors are also wellmarked, I have done well with them. Just recently, I have been working on the tort variety and I am hoping my doe will produce some nice torts soon.

I enjoy the whole Dutch breed for many reasons. One is the challenge of trying to reach the goal of producing the ideal Dutch according to the Standard. Also, there are the people who raise Dutch; they are all so nice and helpful to everyone. I've seen some competitors, open and youth, at shows that are too competitive, but most Dutch breeders are friendly and supportive. The open breeders encourage the youth too. To me, I think what is important is not just if you win or lose, but if you have fun and learn from the whole experience.

I know that I have learned a lot, including management, responsibility and finances. I have also learned that no one person's opinion can make a difference and no one should base any decisions on just that. I have also learned about life, diseases and even death. The main thing I've learned is that I like it when rabbits that I have produced and taken care of do well, and also when a rabbit I have sold to a young member starting out does well.

This year I was asked to be the Rabbit Leader of a local 4-H Club and to teach six kids starting out about rabbits. I started two of



them out with Dutch. This year they will all start to show, breed and do showmanship. It is a lot of fun to watch their pride and confidence grow and see joy in them with their achievements.

Because I share a rabbitry with my sister, who raises 13 pound rabbits, there is a limit to the amount of space I have to raise Dutch. I only have 20 holes, 3 of them being breeding cages. I average 6 - 8 litters per year and can only keep the ones I have room for. If I want to keep a young one or buy a new one, I must sell one of my other rabbits. It is hard to part with some, especially those that I have raised or had for a while, but the new additions coming in hopefully will be better for my overall program. I breed does at their peak cycle, twice in the morning, and again in the afternoon. I do not cull kits at birth, because I believe that regardless of good or bad markings, all rabbits are sweet and deserve an equal chance at life. Sometimes the DQ rabbits are the friendliest! I sell unshowable juniors to pet stores in my area.

I feed my Dutch Templeton Feed and supplement with Doc's. I give them oat hay also and keep snacks down to an occasional apple or carrot. I do give lots of love and attention to each rabbit and I believe that a rabbit that is not happy can not look its best. My Dutch are not in any direct sunlight, but they have constantly circulated fresh air. They are not directly exposed to any weather conditions, and I run fans and give frozen water bottles in warm weather.

I remember when I had my first leg in Dutch and then my first BOV and BOB. When a buck I produced became a Grand Champion, I really felt that I was on the right track. Soon afterwards, the Reserves and Best in Shows became a dream come true and I was

more encouraged to strive for the best the Dutch breed had to offer. Recently I was very proud to win the California Youth Sweepstakes award, as well as top District 3 youth breeder. It has been rewarding to watch my name move up each year, but what means more than any of these is having open breeders that I have admired for years ask me about my rabbits.

I know that I've come a long way in learning about rabbits, especially the Dutch, but I look forward to continuing to strive for the perfect Dutch, sharing what I've learned with others and all the shows along the way to share experiences and friendships with other Dutch breeders. I thank you for asking me to share my story with you and look forward to meeting more of you in the future!



Nestbox Success

I've been pleasantly surprised this past fall and winter with my success in having litters. It's quite the thrill to already have four month old animals going into the spring show season. This is not the norm for me. Even though I have been raising bunnies for quite a long time, they always seem to outfox me when it comes down to the planning stage. In the past, I decided who was going to meet which buck on what day so I could have babies by that time. I even built a new barn three years ago, and added heat and great lighting, but my does still laughed when I showed up at their cage door ready to wisk them off to their chosen mate. The occasional doe would bless me with a litter. If she felt sorry enough for me.

But this year, I tried another approach, a bit a more time consuming one. And it may be one many of you already go by. I waited for the doe to tell ME when it was okay to do the mother thing. Instead of deciding I was going to breed that nice little lady to that handsome buck when I was ready, I watched for physical signs from the doe. I looked over prospective mommies daily until their vulva was swollen and redpurple, and then suggested the rendezvous. If the doe was flagging her tail while running around in her cage, or rubbing her chin on her bowls, she was also brought to the buck. This has made all the difference in the world for me. My conception rate for my does has been probably close to 95%. I have practiced this on my dwarfs as well, and it has also worked for them. It has also cut down on the number of injuries inflicted on occasion (to me...) when the doe was bound and determined that this was not the right time to breed, and clawed her way up my stomach to my shoulder to escape the buck.

I realize the heating may be a very important factor in my recent success as well as my lighting. But this year, I neither raised the heat over 35 degrees nor had my timers on my lights, something I practiced faithfully for the past three years. The only time I had lights on was for night feeding.

The drawback is that is does take alot more time. But if does are bred as they look ready, it is possible to have continual

....And from Southern Ontario

Winter breeding? I would not attempt it here. Don't let the word "southern" fool you. The waterbowls have frozen solid for all of December and will continue to do so for another two months Getting to the barn is sometimes an accomplishment in itself, what with snowdrifts, etc. Unless the barn is heated. winter breeding is out of the question. Even breeding in spring has not been very successful lately. Often does do not "catch" and scattered litters seem to be the norm rather than the exception. Heavy culling and introducing new stock does not lead to improvement. One wonders if environmental factors such as pollution or pesticides/herbicides in the feed play a role. But two litters out of fifteen matings is not good.

I have only 24 holes and raise mostly

blacks, that are steadily improving. I have 2 chocolate bucks, but in 1/2 years of trying have been unable to get a good doe. This colour is rarely seen in shows. Black is the dominant variety, some blues and a few torts. I have never seen grays in Ontario shows nor do I know of any breeders who own grays. I would like very much to own a trio! Anyone out there to get me started?

Another colour one does not see anymore is yellow. Yet 60 to 70 years ago this colour was widely advertised in standards and livestock journals.

Last year my brother, who lives in the Netherlands, send me a magazine featuring a special edition to mark the 75th Anniversary of The Dutch Rabbit Club (or Hollander Club as it is called). The centre spread pictured 19 accepted colours. Interesting, but I would not want to be a judge.

By the way, as a new member I enjoy the Dutch Reporter very much. You are certainly justified to raise your membership fees. The DR alone is worth it, plus the expertise from the top breeders is invaluable to us all. However, I must agree with Richard Gehr's objections and his proposal. May be we should give it a try! Nothing ventured, nothing gained. I believe rabbit breeders in general and Dutch breeders in particular are the nicest people one may meet and I am sure their generosity is not to be under estimated.

Finally, could you explain what is meant by "Best Display" in the Louisville Show Report? I am not familiar with this term and would appreciate some enlightenment. Keep up the good works.



Maximizing your chances

by Kevin Hooper

I have written this article in response to an article in the last DR by Allen Barr which was co-authored by Jill Dobson (page 21). Allen has some good points in his article but there are some statements with which I take issue.

The last paragraph of the article says that there have been articles published recently that gave bad advice in his opinion. I have checked the last six issues and the only color articles other than mine was one on chocolates from Janet Satulla, and a comment from Fran Schettler on Gray ring color. Therefor, I feel I am qualified to respond since he was disagreeing with my advice.

Counterpoints

Gray Dutch - It was said that there has been "indiscriminate" (random, or haphazard by definition) crossing of steels into grays. I do no breeding that does not have genetic principles to back it up, as I will show.

Steel Dutch - I do not practice "unorthodox breeding." (Not adhering to standard practices by definition.) Allen states that the steel is a man made variety. What was it made from? How was it made. What colors were used? The only color needed to produce our Steel is Black and Gray. This we will see as well.

Genetic (in common terms) principles Check out pages 46-49 of the Dutch Guidebook. Try to fit some of your animals into these codes. That is the best way to learn how this works.

Four sets of letters make up the genetic code for color on a Dutch. A or a (agouti or non agouti), B or b, which we will ignore for now. (It's the chocolate gene.) D or d, dilute gene, (turns black to blue, choc to lilac, tort to fawn, etc.) and the Banding genes, E, eg, or e. We will ignore e as it is the tort gene. The eg puts banding on the hairshaft. The E is a non-banded hair.

One letter from each set from each parent gets passed to the offspring. Four different letters from each parent combine in the offspring.

Grays and steels are created by the presence of the Agouti gene (A), and the banding gene(s), eg.

For examples sake and in my herd, NONE of the grays or steels have chocolate or tort genes present. I've proven this by test breeding. Therefore, they have all BB (no choc), DD (no blue - in the examples only) and no e (tort).

Having eg eg gives complete banding to the hairshaft with the presence of at least one agouti gene (A), creating a gray. The E in combination with the eg partially covers the banding creating a steel. This shows that the steel is a narrow band agouti, not a wide band.

A steel MUST have at least one A. It also must have the combination of E eg. If a steel has aa, it will not be a steel, but a black. The presence of two non-agouti genes (aa) will cover or dominate

what the E eg is doing. A Eeg (steel)

A gray must have at least one A, and it must have eg eg. (no tort present so no e present) A_egeg (gray)

You may get steels by not using grays, but the chances are lower. As Allen stated, one of the biggest problems with steels he has seen is the dark back. I have shown that the steel must have an Agouti gene. What happens if it has two agouti genes? Less banding will be covered, because of the absence of the non-agouti gene, therefor, no dark backs. The AA will increase the occurrence of lighter steels as well. I'm using gravs to increase the occurrence of the agouti gene. If I breed a gray with all gray background, test bred to show AA not Aa, to a steel with one A, here's what will happen. A breeder of steels wants as many steels as possible. Keep in mind, you could get all steels or grays, but these are the chances.

1. Gray x Dark Steel = All agouti
AA egeg Aa Eeg AA Eeg Double
agouti steel

AA egeg Double agouti gray
Aa Eeg Single agouti steel
Aa egeg single agouti gray

The double agouti's should be slightly lighter because there is no non-agouti factor to cover the bands. Chance of steel, 50%.

Let's breed steel to steel, two darker ones, and see what we get

2. Aa Eeg x Aa Eeg = AA EE Double Agouti BLACK

AA Eeg Steel
AA egeg Gray
Aa EE Single Agouti BLACK
Aa Eeg Steel
Aa egeg Gray
aa EE Black (pure black)
aa Eeg Black
aa egeg Black

Note only a 2/9 chance for steels, one of which should have a darker back. As a steel breeder, I don't like those odds.

Note some strange things here. The last two blacks if bred to a double agouti steel or gray will produce lots of steels and grays. So, blacks do have a stronger chance of producing steels or grays if they are out of steels or grays, because they might carry either the Agouti gene or the banding gene. A black out of this combo will have an 80% chance of carrying the Agouti or the banding gene.

Let's try a Double agouti gray to a non-agouti black.

3. AA egeg x aaEE - black with no banding (eg) or agouti (A)

= Aa Eeg

Aa Eeg This is your only possible combination out of breeding. All single agouti steels.

If this was the breeding, I would have an entire litter of steels, 100% chance!

Let's do as Allen suggests and ad a blue to our steel. I will presume this is a non-agouti blue with only EE genes. (Solid color only but blue.)

4. aa dd EE (blue) x Aa DD Eeg (Steels with only one agouti gene & no blue)

= Aa EE Single Agouti black
Aa Eeg Steel
aa EE PURE BLACK
aa Eeg Black with one banded gene

Note 25% chance for steel possible, and 75% black. But also note that Allen suggested that none of the blacks out of this combination should be kept. You would be culling one of the PURE Blacks out, as well as a black (the first one) that could be bred to a gray with AA and get 75% steels, and a black (last one) that if bred to the AA gray would give you half grays and half steels.

One more combo - lets use a pure black aa EE (with no blue) and breed it to a AA Blue Gray!

5. aa DD EE x AA dd egeg (Blue-Gray)= Aa Dd Eeg an entire litter of steels 100 % chance, with the blue gene along for the ride. (The big D keeps the d from showing)

Steels are a man made color. If you want to produce many of them, this is how you maximize your chances and get good color at the same time. Don't forget you also have to have a body and markings.

One note, steels will not breed true (produce all steels if bred together). This includes blue steels, choc steels, and lilac steels. You may get all steels occasionally, but you were lucky. See example 2.

Now, as for not using any steels into grays. First I don't, nor do I recommend doing this to help in the breeding of grays. I do this to help the steels. Gray to Gray will give you the best chance for good grays. However, if we look at some of the above examples, and we only have grays in the herd with good ring definition as I have always expressed, you will get good grays from this crossing. If I had not been using my grays into my steels. I would not have had the 1st place Gray sr buck at the convention. He was a nicely colored buck with good ring pattern and 3/4 steel grandparents. I also wouldn't have had the 1st place gray sr doe who has good color and 1/2 steel parentage, or the 2nd place Gray sr doe with nice color and two steel parents.


These are well thought out and proven genetic methods that work. Study those pages in the guidebook and figure the formulas for your animals. It will eliminate the guesswork, and you will understand proper genetics.

What does it look like? To approximately 95% of the Dutch raisers and approximately 70% of our judges, it would be considered a poor Tort. It is primarily orange in color, in fact it is almost impossible to differentiate from a true Tort at birth. As it matures, black ticking will appear at the end of the hair shaft. The ears will resemble the agouti coloring of a gray Dutch, including heavy ear lacings. It will have eye circles, the same as all other agouti varieties (chestnut, chinchilla, opal & lynx). The belly color will be white or cream (again, like a gray). Lap spots will be visible in the groin area. And it will have shadow bars on the feet. There WILL NOT be any shadings

although the black ticking may be heavier on the lower hindquarter giving the impression of shadings. It will have a ring pattern with only two rings rather than the usual three or more. The base ring is white/cream turning into an orange with only a sparse dusting of guard hairs that displays black tipping. Each color band is approximately 1/2 of the hair shaft.

Where does it come from? They ARE NOT a cross from breedings Torts to Grays! They appear in litters of grays bred to grays for successive generations - a dilute. (Similar to a lilac from a chocolate to chocolate breeding.)

What do you do with them? Treat them like a very valuable & golden nugget! Our 1996/2000 Standard of Perfection states for

Brown Grav Dutch, "Absence of intermediate ring color over the colored portion of the body" is a DISQUALIFICATION FROM COMPETITION. If you are one of the breeders who uses steels and grays together. you are now searching madly for grays with "good ring" (or "a medium tan band"). The wide band gray can be your salvation. As early as two months of age gravs from a wide band gray parent will display distinct banding. The tan band against the lower (base) band of slate blue and the upper band of charcoal brown brings clarity and sharpness to each color. Everything must be done with moderation. Use the wide band gray sparingly. They really are a valuable & rare golden nugget!


