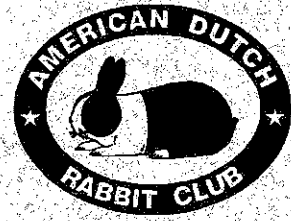


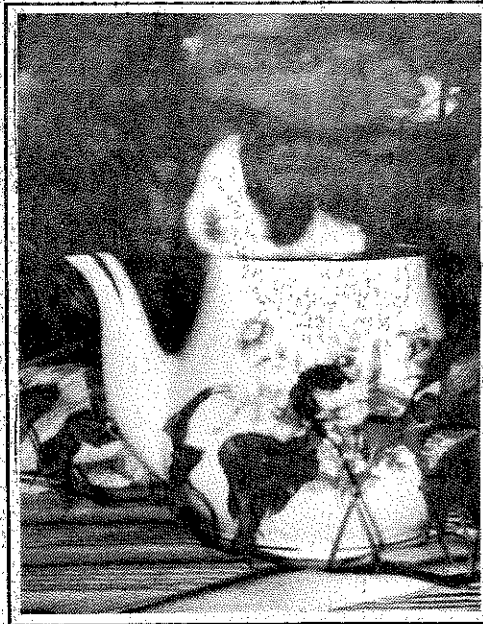

At the '97 NDS at Greenville I visited with a long time Dutch breeder and I told him I think it would be great to see a chinchilla Dutch. He said that there was one that looked chin. The true gray was that color. He went on to say that when he started in Dutch, Dale Zenter's and Wayne Simmons's Grays were similar to the chin color. I thought about it and just like a blue gray is opal to me, the TRUE Gray would be chin to me. Just like the brown gray really looks chestnut to me (K know this is another subject though). But the reason why I would love to see the chin in Dutch is look at other breeds with chin varieties and the lines of chin color to white, impressive!

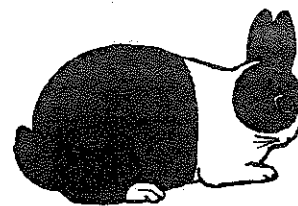

## Color Questions and Comments

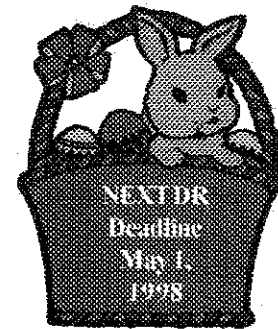
**A**n article was in the last DR written by judge Al Butler. He made a comment on the Torts and keeping the blacks and blues out of the torts. Are any of you breeding blues and blacks to torts, to get torts? I have yet to ever keep or show a tort, that wasn't tort to tort. I can look back generations before I find a non-tort. Yet I still get dark torts, and torts that are too light, and nicely colored torts. I have a tort buck that is out of two blacks that I will be showing at the NDS. He is very little, looks dark now, but I have had them lighten up as they mature. My question is, are our darker torts coming from the influence of blacks and blues, or just the variance that we

see in torts? Tort breeders let me hear from you.

I have used my old tort buck in my blacks. His grand kids and great grand kids are the blacks that have been doing well for me at the last few national shows. He has helped the quality of my blacks, but it is taking a while to get the tort gene back out of my blacks.

One observation on the Grays (I'll never get used to Brown-Gray). Al mentioned that there is too much color on the belly. From what I have seen in my grays, (had over 60 in the last year that were nice enough to keep, and were tattooed) the bolder the ring color on the top, the more belly color that is going to be present. This was figured in when the last Standard revision was done. That is why it calls for white or cream surface

to the belly. Also, the width of the bands of color on the fur are going to be very dependent on the length on the coat of fur. I think Al had it right, a happy medium is needed.... medium in between wide and narrow is the proper width to the bands. The Grays, Steels and Torts are always going to vary in color slightly from animal to animal, just as our blacks, blues, and chocs do. There is not as much attention paid to the variances in color in our blacks and our blues as there is in the grays, torts, and steels.

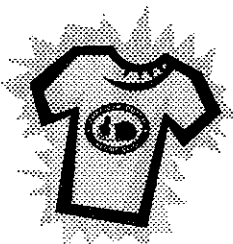

## PREPARING FOR THE BIG SHOW

I believe in preparing for a big show you either have it or you do not. I do not buy into the belief that you can win a big show just by steps taken in the month or months leading up to the show. The only way I know of to truly prepare for any show is to have a good breeding program backed up by a consistent feeding and cleaning program. I personally do very little grooming on my animals. I have found that if you provide your animals with a clean living space they will do all the grooming needed themselves. The only thing I will do is go over an animal that is in a molt with a saw blade or brush to removed the dead lose hair.

Many people believe that special treats help to bring animals into condition. I tend to feel that consistency is best and by adding a new food staple to the diet just prior to a show you risk causing more damage then good. I do provide treats for my animals on a regular basis such as some hay, straw, sunflower seeds or other treats. I do not however depend on these treats to in any way enhance the condition of my animals. The animals that end up at the top of the class at the big shows are animals in a natural prime condition. I can not speak for other breeders but if you walk around a national show or two you will seldom see the top breeders doing a lot of cleaning and grooming. Those top breeders spent their time over years of breeding for animals that can present themselves in a natural condition on a consistent basis. For example Kevin Hooper's buck KT39 is a buck that has been able to hold condition for long periods of time not only as a young animal but even as he gets up in years he is still able to maintain good fur and flesh. I don't know if Kevin will like me using this example but he won't see this until it is to late.

These are my thoughts on preparing for the BIG show or any show.

Breed lots and cull hard. Feed, water, and clean often. My final thought would be ask the old timers for advise and be patient. These are two tricks to becoming one of those TOP breeders.

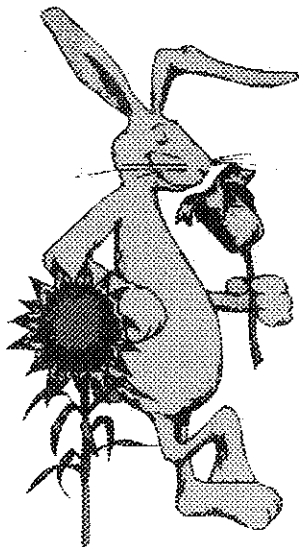

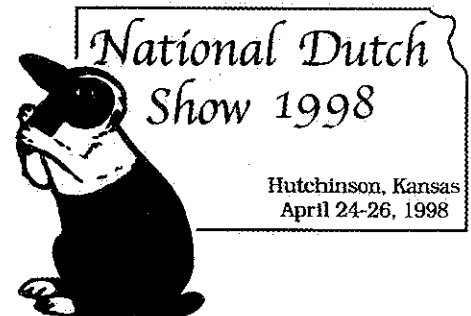

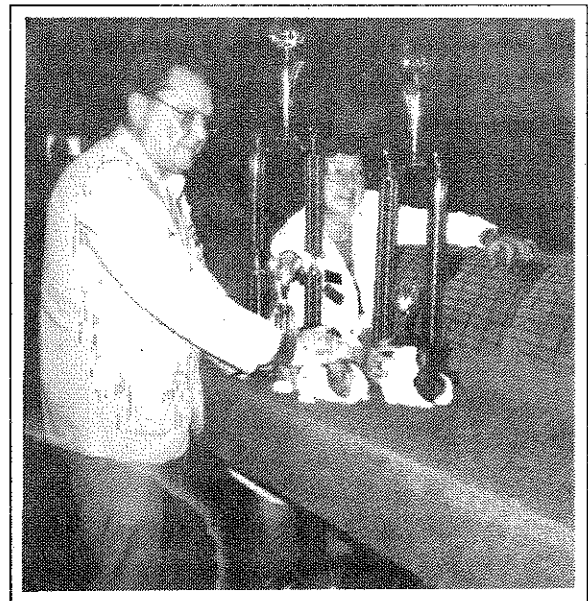

# STANDARD COMMITTEE REPORT

## Fellow Dutch Enthusiasts:

During the past few months the ADRC Standards Committee has been diligently reviewing the Dutch standard for possible revisions to be implemented into the upcoming 2001 - 2005 ARBA Standard of Perfection.

Careful consideration was used throughout all aspects of the standard including:

- Reviewing of breed disqualification's.
- Conformity between wording in the standard and picture illustrations.
- Terminology and grammatical changes.
- Aspects observed in the showroom.
- Feedback from judges, registrars and breeders.

Again, our goal was (and is) to support a standard that is precise, accurate, achievable and easy to interpret. A standard that is as easy for the novice to understand yet challenging enough for the veteran to try and master. (Remember, in all the years of the Dutch rabbit there has never been a perfect one.)

The proposals mentioned here are just that ... proposals. They are for you the membership to review. Following each proposal is a brief explanation of why such should or could be implemented. Please take the time to review each aspect and keep an open mind. We are looking to improve our Dutch breed as a whole ... not one to compliment an individuals herd.

This is not an official ballot. But rather something to review back to time and time again throughout the year. An official ballot will appear later this year in the Dutch Reporter. We would like to forward our balloting results to the ARBA Standards Committee Chairman soon after the new year (1999) as possible for their review. Again, the ADRC Standard is the property of the ARBA not the ADRC. It is our responsibility as Dutch breeders to promote, encourage and improve the breeding of the Dutch rabbit. This is one way we can help achieve that.

One area being looked into, but not yet ready for print is the description of the Brown Gray. A survey is being conducted directed towards the breeders of the Brown Gray on their views on certain issues. If you are a breeder of Brown Grays and have not taken part in this survey, and would like to, please forward your name to committee member Marti Dill so she can forward you the necessary forms.

If there are any questions concerning any of these proposals please feel free to contact me or any of the standards committee members. I am sure they will be more than willing to help answer your questions. We value your input. Together let us continue to strive to make the Dutch "America's Finest Rabbit"

### REQUESTED JUDGING ORDER:

BLACK - BLUE - CHOCOLATE - TORTOISE - STEEL - GRAY

### SHOWROOM CLASSES AND WEIGHTS

Junior Bucks and Does - under 6 months of age, minimum wt. 1 3/4 pounds

\* We would request no junior maximum weight be set, as this would penalize fast maturing animals. Example: a 4 1/2 lb. 5 month old buck would be forced to be bumped up into the senior buck class.

NOTE: All breeds will be assessed a minimum junior weight in the next standard by the ARBA.

## GENERAL TYPE - 35 pts.

\*\* To stress more importance to proper Dutch body type and conformation. Currently type is only half as important as markings. It is TYPE along with markings that make a good Dutch. Markings will remain slightly higher in point value, but not to the severity it is now. (You can put the Dutch markings on the body of a Himalayan, a Britannia Petite or New Zealand but that does not make them a Dutch)

## BODY - 24 pts.

Description would remain the same with the deletion of the last sentence ... **The feet, legs, and tail should have the proper length and size to balance and harmonize with the compact body.** (this sentence will be implemented into the FEET & LEGS section.)

*Faults* - Large protruding hips that lose smoothness and roundness; Potty, flat bodied, narrow or racy specimens are undesirable. Cut severely for pinched, undercut or chopped hindquarters; prominent dewlaps. \*\* A simple rewording that will focus more importance to proper hindquarter structure.

## FEET & LEGS - 2 pts.

The feet and legs are to be straight, medium-fine in bone, and have the proper length and size to balance and harmonize with the compact body. Toenails are to be white in all varieties.

*Faults* - Extremely fine bone. Broken toenails.

*Disqualification from Competition* - Any colored toenail(s)

\*\* This section was developed out of the current BODY description to emphasize the importance of good leg development and help overcome the problems of cow-hocks which have been evident in many animals through the years.

## COLOR DESCRIPTIONS:

**STEEL** - *Disqualification's from competition* - Ring pattern over the back or upper sides. \*\* Currently reads "Ring pattern over the back and upper sides". The DQ should apply if rings appear in either area, not necessarily both areas.

**TORTOISE** - *Disqualification's from competition* - Absence of shadings altogether. (Self-explanatory)

**GRAY** - description forthcoming pending results of survey. \*\* Currently termed as BROWN-GRAY, there has been much feedback on reverting back to the original name GRAY. The words BROWN will remain in the description of banding on the hairshaft. Plus, it is the only variety of Gray the Dutch has. It has also caused some confusion as to judging sequences in the showroom.

## MARKINGS

**Hairline** - The hairline is to be a narrow line running between the ears, entirely dividing each cheek marking and ear, connecting the white portions of the blaze and neck marking.

\*\* Simple grammatical changes adding the terms "marking" and "neck marking". The term neck is referred to later in that same paragraph, so the term collar would be dropped for clarity and consistency.

**Undercut** - *Disqualification from competition* - When the body

color extends past the elbow joint onto the foreleg. \*\* Current description states when color extends below the elbow. This has caused some confusion when the animal is in the rolled-over position. If the color extended "below" (meaning lower or under according to Webster's dictionary) the elbow, it would not be a tied leg. This version would give a clearer description on where the color must be to be a DQ.

## Marking point distribution:

See previous listing. \*\* It was felt that since there would be more points devoted towards BODY TYPE, markings would need to be adjusted accordingly. The CHEEKS, SADDLE and STOPS will continue to have the most value. The BLAZE will remain the same as well. Points were taken from the UNDERCUT and NECK areas for a couple reasons. They are less visible when the rabbit is sitting in its natural state and are not cut severely when they are faulted. Currently a Dutch who has a full-neck would be cut 5 pts. Yet, if a Dutch were missing a blaze, also worth 4 pts., that rabbit would be DQ. So why have them be worth the same? Furthermore, the undercut is currently worth more (8 pts.) than the blaze as well. I think it would be safe to say that it is much more of a challenge to achieve a nice blaze with well-balanced cheeks than to get a straight line that 90% of the time goes unnoticed.

## Dutch Drawings Captions:

**DISQUALIFICATION:** (1) Long Stop, a disqualification when the white reaches above the hook joint; (2) Split Stop, a disqualification when color runs between toes and connects with the color on the bottom of the foot; (3) Undercut - Hooked on leg, color dragging onto white of leg. When color extends past the joint, it disqualifies.

**BODY TYPE:** (1) Ideal, short, cobby type, well rounded hips, good depth throughout; (2) Good depth of body, but too long; cheeks and stops too long; (3) Body too long and narrow, with poor depth; cheeks and stops long; pear shaped head.

\*\* Recommended caption wording brings the pictures and the description in the body copy of the standard into better conformity.

## DUTCH STANDARD

As we move into the next century our standard is very poorly written because it does not have enough descriptive terms and has too much in other places. We should be striving for a perfect standard since we are striving for the perfect Dutch. Our standard should also be simple enough for anyone off the street with no understanding of rabbits to have a shadow picture in their mind, along with being descriptive enough to detail that picture. I went to my friends and one professor to get their feed back about how this standard is written. I believe the question is how descriptive do we get but still be simple enough? There is a very fine line that we should be trying to find.

Remember high school or college and your teacher or professor telling you to be very descriptive, but do not over kill that report? I would have to say, we have a very over killed standard. I believe we should solve this one word, "balance"! The word balance (width equaling depth) is so important because it would simplify but also make the body description even more descriptive. Right now, to have good type is a top line and taper so the width could be four inches while the depth be seven inches. I have an assignment for you. Look in the standard and read the body type of the Dutch (pg. 103), then read the Florida White (pg. 121). Which one describes the body better? Which one is shorter, more simple to understand, and more descriptive? I bet nine out of ten will say the Florida White. Now image a Dutch that has type of a Florida White description and I bet that Dutch will be our next BIS winner at an ARBA Convention. Now if you

seriously still do not believe this, take this assignment to a friend and see which they would pick? I did!

Now to simplify the parts of the Dutch descriptions. First the head — I never knew the neck is part of the head. I thought the neck would be included with body, along with the feet and legs. Are we sure we want judges to be looking at more things, because this makes it harder to judge? Or, do we want them to be included with body and maybe keep it a little easier for the judges. I believe they should be included with body because only the very good body types will possess these traits.

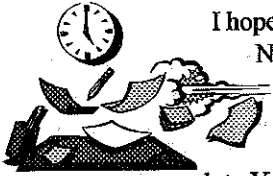
Brown Gray is a color that needs a lot of help. My professor gave me an explanation after I explained agouti pattern and ring color, that would shorten it in half or even two-thirds. I sent this to the standards committee. Another things to shorten up is the description of the undercut of the Brown Gray. Why is this in the color portion? I would think it would be in the description of the undercut.

We say to breed for type but the standard says to breed for markings. What Kevin wrote about the standards committee proposed is a great idea in the right direction. We can simplify how the Dutch are judged by moving the points a little by thinking of the points as percents and what we want in order of importance. Is type really only 25% of Dutch? I say no, how about 40%. Then, how about this: 40 points on markings, 45 points on general type (40 of those points on body type), and 5 points on color, fur, and condition. What I am trying to do is keep a class of four place the same whether it is at a local or national show and a judge that is familiar with Dutch or a judge that has not judged them before.

If we are to change anything in our standard we should have a purpose for these changes. My purpose is that I want every judge to place my rabbits the same, not my best one place last and my worst one wins BOB. I know that every judge judging the same is impossible, but there is no reason for the extremes to happen. Thank you for reading my concerns and opinions about our standard. If you agree with any of them, please write to Eric Mixdorf or another committee member.

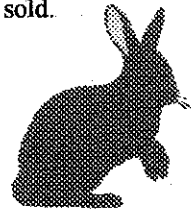

# AMERICAN DUTCH RABBIT CLUB CONSTITUTION AND BY-LAWS

## CONSTITUTION

**ARTICLE I - NAME:** The name of this club shall be the AMERICAN DUTCH RABBIT CLUB, INCORPORATED.

**ARTICLE II - OBJECT:** The object of this club shall be to promote, encourage, and improve the breeding of Dutch rabbits by maintaining an organization to study standards, encourage exhibitions, and offer service to its members.

**ARTICLE III - AFFILIATION:** This club shall be affiliated with the American Rabbit Breeders Association, Inc.

### **ARTICLE IV - MEMBERSHIP:**

**Section 1:** Any person of good character and reputation and in accord with the object may become a member of the club upon presentation of a signed application together with membership fee for at least one year to the Secretary-Treasurer. Term of membership to be one year from date on membership application, providing a application is received within five (5) days of this date. Each member shall be provided with a copy of the latest A.D.R.C. Guidebook, if available, and a one (1) year subscription to the Dutch Reporter.

**Section 2:** Any member having paid thirty-five (35) consecutive years adult membership regardless of age, or that has twenty-five (25) consecutive years membership in the A.D.R.C. upon reaching the age of sixty-five (65), shall be awarded a Life Membership.

### **ARTICLE V - OFFICERS:**

**Section 1:** The elected officers of this association shall consist of a President, Vice-President, and nine (9) directors, who shall be elected for a three (3) year term, by and from the membership. The Secretary-Treasurer shall be appointed by the President, approved by two-thirds (2/3) majority of the Board of Directors, excluding the Secretary-Treasurer. The appointment of the Secretary-Treasurer shall be for three (3) years. Any member, to be eligible for office, must be an owner and breeder of Dutch rabbits.

**Section 2:** The Secretary-Treasurer may be reappointed by the Board of Directors, who may also remove him/her from office, for cause, by a two-thirds (2/3) majority, during any term of office. The Secretary-Treasurer will be an active voting member of the board of directors, except in the appointment or removal from office of Secretary-Treasurer. The Board of Directors, therefore, consists of the President, Vice-President, Secretary-Treasurer, and nine (9) directors. The term of any office shall begin on January 1st of the year following each election.

**Section 3:** The President and one (1) director representing each district will be elected for a three (3) year tenure. The Vice-President and one (1) director from each district will be elected the following year for a three (3) year tenure. Finally, the Secretary-Treasurer will be appointed and the final three (3) directors, each from a different district will be elected the third year to serve a three (3) year tenure. Directors may be from the same state and district as other officers: President, Vice-President, and Secretary-Treasurer. The directors representing each district will be elected by a vote of only those members living in that district.

**District 4:** Vacancies in office shall be filled by appointment by the President, subject to approval by a two-thirds (2/3) majority vote of the Board of Directors. If filling the office of director, a person from the same district the vacancy is in, shall be appointed.

**SECTION 5 - DISTRICTS:** Directors shall be elected from three (3) districts divided as follows:

1- Connecticut, Delaware, Florida, Georgia, Maine, Maryland, Massachusetts, New Hampshire, New Jersey, New York, North Carolina, Ohio, Pennsylvania, Rhode Island, South Carolina, Vermont, Virginia, West Virginia.

2- Alabama, Arkansas, Illinois, Indiana, Iowa, Kentucky, Louisiana, Michigan, Minnesota, Mississippi, Missouri, Tennessee, Wisconsin.

3- Alaska, Arizona, California, Colorado, Hawaii, Idaho, Kansas, Montana, Nebraska, Nevada, New Mexico, North Dakota, Oklahoma, Oregon, South Dakota, Texas, Utah, Washington, Wyoming.

*\* NOTE: No foreign member will be eligible to hold office.*

### **ARTICLE VI - ELECTION PROCEDURES:**

**Section 1:** Any member wishing to run for an elected ADRC office or Board position shall submit a resume to the Secretary-Treasurer, prior to May 1st, in the year the office or Board Position shall be voted upon, stating the position for which they wish to become a candidate. The resume shall be printed in the April-May-June Issue of the Dutch Reporter. All candidates must be current ADRC and ARBA members, and be actively breeding Dutch Rabbits. Any member to be eligible for office must have been in continuous good standing at least two (2) years prior to May 1st of the year in which the election is being held, and all candidates shall remain in good standing with membership fee paid in advance at least through the date of assuming office, January 1st.

**Section 2:** Final numbered election ballots, shall be mailed out by August 1st to eligible voting members. Ballots shall then be marked and placed in a pre-addressed envelope and returned to the ADRC Election Committee Chairman by September 15th, at which time the polls shall be closed. The Chairman of the Election Committee, will assemble the Election Committee, open and count the ballots, and certify the results to the Secretary-Treasurer, President, and Dutch Reporter Editor, within 22 days. The Election Chairman shall then package the final Ballots and send them to the Secretary-Treasurer of the ADRC, and they shall be retained for a period of one (1) year, at which time they may be destroyed. These ballots, while in the hands of the Secretary-Treasurer, shall be accessible to any member in good standing, provided proper arrangements are made with the Secretary-Treasurer.

**Section 2a:** No one (1) person can run for more than one (1) office during any election.

**Section 3:** The Sec-Treas shall then inform the candidates and the board of Directors of the results within three weeks, and shall declare the candidate/s having the highest number of votes elected. The officer/s elect shall assume offices on the following January 1st and serve their elected terms or

until their successors have been elected or duly appointed. In the case of a tie for any office, a majority vote of the remaining Board of Directors shall break the tie.

**Section 4:** If any candidate is running unopposed for office, they shall be declared elected. No ballot will be issued for an unopposed office. Any office where no candidate has submitted a resume, shall be filled by appointment by the President with a 2/3 majority approval of the Board of Directors.

#### **ARTICLE VII- DISCIPLINE:**

**Section 1:** The Board of Directors may, by a two-thirds (2/3) majority, suspend or expel any member or reject an application for membership or renewal, providing charges have been preferred by another member. Less than a two-thirds (2/3) majority shall constitute acquittal of the charges.

**Section 2:** In the event of preferment of charges, the member against whom the charges have been made shall be fully informed by the Secretary-Treasurer and given thirty (30) days to reply before action is taken by the Board. If reply is made, it shall be considered by the board along with the charges.

**Section 3:** Any person expelled, suspended, or otherwise rejected shall not be eligible for reinstatement for a period of at least one (1) year, and then only upon authority of the Board of Directors.

**Section 4:** An officer whose membership has expired shall be notified by the Secretary-Treasurer by registered mail, with signature receipt requested, and if the renewal has not been made in thirty (30) days from the date of expiration, said office shall be declared vacant and it shall be the duty of the President to fill by appointment the unexpired term of office.

**Section 5:** An officer who shows lack of interest in his official duties, who fails to answer correspondence of Club matters from his fellow officers, shall be asked by the President to resign said office. In case of failure to do so, the Board of Directors by two-thirds (2/3) majority vote shall declare the office vacant. It shall then be the duty of the President to appoint an officer to fill the unexpired term of office.

**Section 6:** An officer who shall willingly or otherwise give up the breeding of Dutch rabbits during his term of office shall automatically resign his office and it shall be the duty of the President to fill the vacancy of the unexpired term of office by appointment.

**Section 7:** No member or candidate for membership may infringe upon the name of the American Dutch Rabbit Club, Inc., or that of any other member of his rabbitry. This also applies to State Dutch Rabbit Clubs.

#### **ARTICLE VIII MEETINGS:**

**Section 1:** The annual membership meeting shall be held during the annual Convention of the American Rabbit Breeders Association, Inc.

**Section 2:** A regular membership meeting shall be held during the National Dutch Rabbit Show; however, this meeting shall in no way replace the annual meeting unless the two (2) are concurrent.

**Section 3:** The President, or in the absence of the President, any elected officer present may call a meeting of the Board of Directors at any time during the annual Convention of the American Rabbits Breeders Association, Inc. or the National Dutch Rabbit Show. The presence of five (5) officers at such a meeting shall constitute a quorum.

**ARTICLE IX - AMENDMENTS:** Any alteration of, or amendment to the Constitution and By-Laws shall be made by way of a resolution. This resolution must be submitted to the Secretary of the ADRC in writing, no later than thirty (30) days prior to the opening day of the National Dutch Show or the ARBA Convention. The secretary shall send copies of the resolution to each officer of the ADRC for their review. Said resolution shall be reviewed and discussed at the next Board of Directors meeting, with the board, by 2/3 majority, either supporting or rejecting the resolution. The resolution and the Board's recommendations would then be read by the ADRC Secretary at the next general membership meeting, with ample opportunity for discussions. The resolution and the Board's recommendation would then be printed in the next issue of the Dutch Reporter. Voting on the proposed amendment would be held with the annual ballots, to be mailed out August 1st. The Constitution may be amended by a 2/3 majority of all eligible votes cast. All amendments shall take effect the January 1st after the election.

### **BY-LAWS**

#### **ARTICLE I - DUES**

Dues - The membership Dues shall be:

Adult \$10.00

Youth \$8.00

Husband/Wife \$14.00

Family Membership \$20.00

Youth must be 18 years of age or under at the time of application. A family membership shall consist of no more than two adults and their children (18 years of age or younger) who are in the household, at the same address.

Only one Dutch Reporter and Guidebook shall be mailed to a Husband/wife membership or a family membership.

Lifetime memberships for Adult and Husband/Wife members can be purchased for twenty (20) times the current membership fees, payable in advance, by those members 35 years of age or older. All deductions from paid life memberships are excluded.

One dollar of each membership shall be placed into a separate account called the "Guidebook/Contingency Fund", and the provisions of Article III - Sections 1 and 2 of the By-laws shall not be applied to these monies.



Membership dues are good for a one year period, beginning from when the membership is processed. After membership has expired, the member may renew within a period of sixty (60) days; otherwise upon sending in membership fees, the member will be given a new membership number unless they request that their membership be back dated more than 60 days to the original expiration date, in order that they may keep continuous membership and the original membership number. Any member having been delinquent sixty (60) days or more, shall be deprived of all sweepstakes points accumulated prior to the expiration date. All youth members retain all of the privileges as adults except for voting.

#### **ARTICLE II - DUTIES OF OFFICERS:**

**Section 1:** The President shall preside at all meetings of the membership or Board of Directors, appoint all committees, fill all vacancies in office by appointment, and perform such duties as pertain to the office.

**Section 2:** The Vice-President shall perform all duties of the President in his absence or disability. In event of vacation of the office of President, the Vice-President shall automatically succeed him in office.

**Section 3:** The Secretary-Treasurer shall be custodian of all general funds; shall maintain a bank account in the name of the club; shall maintain a set of books and records suitable to the Board of Directors; receive and act on all membership applications received, subject to the approval of the Board of Directors; maintain Sweepstakes Show records; consult and advise the Board of Directors on all unusual matters; furnish them with quarterly reports showing the general condition of the club; furnish the Board of Directors with semi-annual audited reports, all these reports to be published in the club's publication; keep an accurate record of all meetings; and perform such other duties as may be assigned by the President of the Board of Directors. The Secretary-Treasurer shall furnish an approved bond covering the assets of the club. The premium for said bond to be paid for out of club funds, with the bond to be delivered to the President within ten (10) days after assumption of office.

**Section 4:** It shall be the duty of the Secretary to edit or cause to be edited, the Dutch Reporter. If, for any reason the Secretary is unable to perform this duty, it shall be the duty of the President to appoint a Dutch Reporter Editor subject to 2/3 majority approval of the Board of Directors. The Secretary shall cooperate with the editor by providing such news from the office as would be of interest to the membership.

**Section 5:** The Board of Directors shall have the power to transact all business of the Club between meetings; act upon charges brought before them; formulate rules; award the location of the National Dutch Rabbit Show; and decide upon all questions of policy brought before them.

#### **ARTICLE III - APPORTIONMENT OF FUNDS**

**Section 1:** The Secretary-Treasurer shall receive twenty-five (25%) of all membership dues including: The renewals, and 25% of sweepstakes fees as full compensation for his/her services.

**Section 1a:** The sweepstakes chairperson shall receive one dollar (\$1.00) per open show sanction paid from the open show sanction fee as remuneration to compensate for time and effort spent by said chairperson in calculating, tabulating, and recording all show results. The sweepstakes chairperson shall provide the Dutch Reporter editor with a typed copy of each show report listed chronologically and sweepstakes standing for both open and youth divisions listed numerically; top twenty (20) open and youth divisions as well as the top five (5) from each district.

**Section 2:** The dues shall be further divided with twelve and one-half percent (12.5%) to be allotted to the ADRC Publicity Department. Any portion of these monies may be transferred to the Publicity Department or to any ADRC purpose, upon approval of the Board of Directors. The remaining sixty two and one-half percent (62.5%) shall go to the General Fund.

**Section 2a:** An annual allotment of five hundred dollars (\$500) from the general fund shall be awarded to the sponsors of the National Dutch Show, with further stipulation that the ADRC receive recognition for this allotment. Said money is to be sent by the Secretary-Treasurer to the sponsors on or as near to the 1st of January, preceding the NDS for that year. Show sponsors must have all NDS judges secured before any allocation is made.

The ADRC Board has the authority to change the required number of judges as deemed necessary by the number of entries. The open judges shall be the top selections from the ballot if possible.

**Section 2b:** An annual allotment of one hundred fifty dollars (\$150.00) shall be paid out of the General Fund towards the American Rabbit Breeders Association, Inc. Convention, with further stipulation that the entire amount be used for open Dutch specials.

**Section 2c:** An annual allotment of \$150 shall be paid out of the General fund towards the ARBA Convention, with further stipulation that the entire amount be used for youth Dutch Specials.

**Section 2d:** All of the above allotted specials to be advertised as being donated by the American Dutch Rabbit Club Inc.

**Section 3:** The President shall receive the sum of fifty dollars (\$50.00) for attendance at each annual, regular, or special meeting, provided that meeting is not held in the town in which he/she resides, in which case there shall be no payment. In no case shall the payment be in excess of the sum of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) per calendar year. The Secretary-Treasurer shall receive the sum of twenty cents (\$.20) per mile round trip, or round trip coach air fare, whichever is less expensive, for travel expenses to the National Dutch Rabbit Shows and the American Rabbit Breeders Association, Inc. Conventions. Should the National Dutch Rabbit Show or the American Rabbit Breeders Association, Inc. Convention take place within 125 miles radius of the Secretary-Treasurer's home, only the sum of fifty dollars (\$50.00) will be paid. In the case that the National Dutch Rabbit Show or the American Rabbit Breeders Association, Inc. Convention should be held in the town in which the Secretary-Treasurer resides, he/she shall receive no payment for expenses.

**Section 3a:** The Publicity Chairman shall be paid one hundred dollars (\$100.00) for each National Dutch Rabbit Show and American Rabbit Breeders Association, Inc. Convention which he/she transports American Dutch Rabbit Club, Inc. publicity items for sale at the Club booth; such funds to be paid from the Publicity Fund.

**Section 4:** Each officer, along with the Chairman of the Publicity Department, shall have the Dutch Reporter mailed to them by first class mail in lieu of any postage.

#### **ARTICLE IV - STANDING COMMITTEES:**

**Section 1:** The Publicity and Promotion Committee shall consist of a chairman and at least two members appointed from the membership by the President for a term of two (2) years with the majority approval of the Board of Directors. Chairman of said committee shall have charge of all publicity and promotion work for the club except for editing the club's publication. Said chairman shall be custodian of and be responsible for the publicity funds and shall give a report at each annual and regular meeting.

**Section 1a:** A quarterly report of the Publicity Department shall be submitted to the Secretary-Treasurer for publication in the Dutch Reporter.

**Section 2:** The Standards Committee shall consist of a chairman and four (4) members, at least two of whom shall be licensed ARBA judges. The Standards Committee shall be appointed from the members in good standing by the President with majority approval of the Board of Directors. They shall be responsible for maintaining a continuous study of the Standards and communicating any proposed revisions or additions to the ADRC Board. Upon majority Board approval, the Secretary shall cause such proposed revisions or additions to be sent to each member in good standing with a mail ballot so that they may register their vote for or against each change, revision, or addition. If these changes, revisions, or additions are approved by a two-thirds (2/3) majority vote of the ballots cast, then the committee must submit them to the ARBA Standards Committee with the recommendations that such changes, revisions, or additions be adopted.

**Section 3:** The Election Committee shall consist of a Chairman and two other members, none of whom shall reside in the same county as either the President or the Secretary-Treasurer. The Election Committee shall be appointed annually by the President, from the membership, with 2/3 majority approval of the Board of Directors. The Election Committee shall assemble and count the ballots, tabulate and certify the results to the President and Secretary-Treasurer within 22 days of receiving the ballots. If all three members of the Election Committee are unable to meet to carry out these duties, the President shall be notified immediately, and different Election Committee members appointed as needed, prior to counting the ballots. It is necessary that the signatures of all three members of the Election Committee accompany the results as sent to the President, and Secretary-Treasurer. No member of the Election Committee shall be eligible for election to any office. Any member serving on the Election Committee shall not be eligible to serve on this committee again for a period of three (3) years.

**Section 4:** The Auditing Committee shall consist of a Chairman and two (2) members, no two (2) of them shall either be officers or reside in the same county as the Secretary-Treasurer. Their duty shall be to make a semi-annual audit of the fiscal period, preceding the National Dutch Rabbit Show, and the American Rabbit Breeders Association Inc. Convention, of the Secretary-Treasurer books and make a report there-on at these meetings. The Committee may recommend, if deemed advisable after examination, that the books be audited by a certified public accountant. The above Committee to be appointed from the membership present at the above mentioned meetings.

**Section 5:** Any special Committee deemed advisable by the President, or authorized by the Board of Directors or membership, may be appointed by the President and given specific assignment. At the completion of their assignment, they shall be discharged.


**ARTICLE V - PARLIAMENTARY AUTHORITY:**

The rules of parliamentary procedure in Roberts Rules of Order shall govern the proceedings of the Club.

**ARTICLE VI - ORDER OF BUSINESS:**

The order of business shall be:
