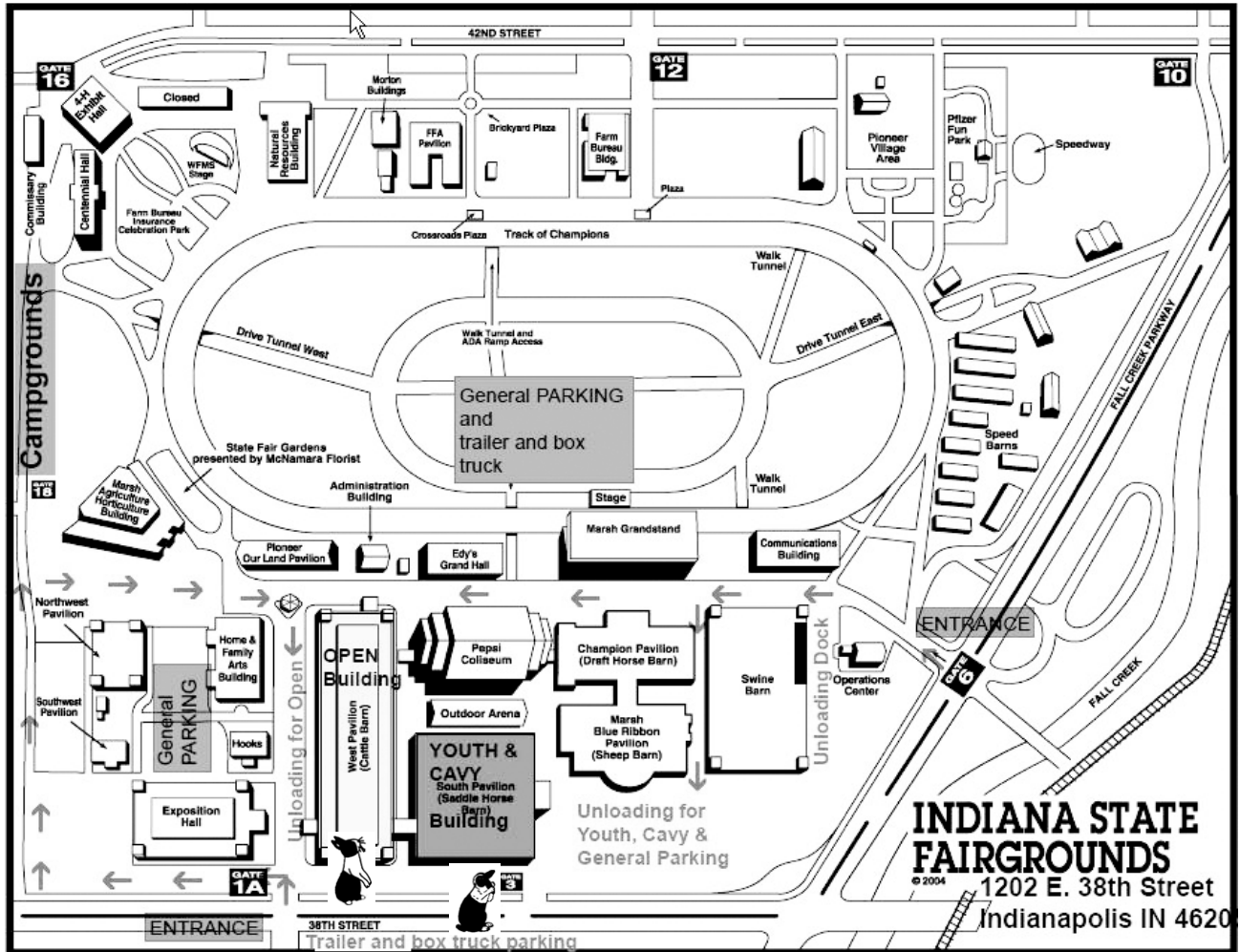

## President Report Sue Hill

**I**f ever a summer will be ingrained in the memories of rabbit raisers, it will be the one from 2011. Record heat and horrific storms have

plagued the midwest for over a month and plaguing breeders with worry over their animals well being. Any possible means to keep a herd surviving through this time is being tried. Several have brought their herd bucks or pregnant does into the house during the hottest parts of the day to keep the bucks fertile and the does comfortable. How it will impact us in the coming months will be apparent in Indianapolis for our ARBA Convention. There have been several reports of rabbit losses, despite the efforts of those working tirelessly to keep their furry friends cooled down. Hopefully, by the time you read this edition of the Dutch Reporter, these parts of the country will have been graced with cooler temperatures and non-damaging rain to put both man and beast at ease.

Things have been rather quiet since NDS in terms of club activity. Your Board continues to work through emails to approach any concerns or business in between conventions. I appreciate the fact that they take the time out of busy schedules to discuss issues when they would much rather be kicked back enjoying a cool summer drink. Kudos to you all, team Dutch Board!

Two items up for discussion at this time--without a final decision being made--is addressing the ages of our Royalty contests for the youngest group. There currently is not a rule for how young a contestant may be to compete. At the same time, we want to continue to encourage our youth to participate in the contests.

Secondly, we are looking into what we may name the group of Dutch Breeders that our Hall of Fame Committee has submitted for recognition. Several names have been submitted, and after the deadline of September 1st for any others from the membership, the Board will vote on which one will be used. You will find the entire group of people that have been an important part of shaping this club as you know it listed elsewhere in this DR. Very, very precious few

are with us today but their past accomplishments and insight have giving us a path to travel down. You, as a Dutch breeder, have the opportunity to nominate someone in this day and age to the prestigious group of Hall of Famers. If you feel someone has been deserving of this recognition, please go to our web site and look under the documents icon to find all the information on how to submit a name. Be sure you get the information in by the required deadlines. You can also talk with one of the Hall of Fame Committee members. Stan Goeglein, the Chairperson, will be at ARBA Convention and would love to have some nominations in his hand for his group to work with!

Julie Hume has added some interesting info to our web site so check it out when you can. Take the survey that is currently up. We want your input! If you have any interesting photos, send them in. Anyone in the news? Let us know! For instance...one of our very talented photographers in the south, Carolyn Hidalgo, has taken some stunning photos of her Dutch. With her skills with editing, they are a delight to look at. And Cody Seymore from California had a wonderful article featuring his beloved Dutch bunnies and his winning record. What great publicity for our breed! To top it off, our breed was highlighted in the most recent Domestic Rabbits magazine, giving the breakdown of how many Dutch were exhibited throughout the past several years at Conventions. It was quite interesting to get those figures and it shows we continue to be one of the "big dogs" at the ARBA fall show! Continue to check the web site on a regular basis to get the information you need. If you don't see it, feel free to contact either Julie or your Director so we can get your questions answered.

Just this past week, California breeders may have suffered a major blow to their rabbit hobby with the passing of a bill that, among other things, is targeting those that raise and sell animals to the general public. Here is the link to bill SB917 to read if you so choose:

Many people have taken time to write to their Senators to voice concerns as this develops. There is still quite a bit of uncertainty as to how it will impact shows, the selling and breeding of domestic rabbits, and the entire industry as a whole if this movement continues into other areas of the country. Our part in this all can



to always put our best foot forward with our hobby; put the welfare of your rabbits to the forefront, breed, raise and sell responsibly, and do your best to educate anyone new to the hobby on how to best take care of their animals. We need to show the public that we have a hobby that respects the health and well being of the rabbits as much as we do the members themselves.

How can we do that? Keep your rabbitry CLEAN. Make sure your animals have the very basics of life you would want for yourself...clean air (ventilation), clean water (and adequate supplies readily available at all times) and fresh food (keep it safe from rodents and store it in containers that will keep out the moisture). If you cannot walk through a rabbitry without feeling the air is stifling, or can detect a strong ammonia odor, then it is time to make some changes so the rabbits that depend on you for everything have a healthy life while in your barn. Consider some gardening clubs or friends that may be interested in taking the manure off your hands if you do not have a spot to compost it. Keep your herd to a size that is manageable. Culling is not a favorite part of rabbit raising, but is, albeit, a necessary one if we are to keep a quality herd. Rabbit meat is a nutritious source of protein and many people welcome having it a part of their diet. It is also becoming a fast favorite among dog breeders that feed a raw diet to their dogs.

Have your pens in good shape. This includes scrubbing out carriers after shows. Repair areas that need new wire and make sure there is not any build up of droppings in the corners the pens. Use pest control measures to get rid of any unwanted visitors. Fly populations stay at bay with the help of sprays that are safe for farm use, or the good old fly strip.

When selling a pet, include a care sheet. Perhaps that is something a handful of our membership can take on and come up with some solid information for the new owner that would be readily available to our club. Think of all those little tidbits you learned over the years to get you to where you are now. Care to share any for others? Any thoughts on that?

At this coming ARBA convention, come on up to our booth and check out all the information we will have out for you. We will have important updates there on a daily basis. In the past, we have asked for anyone interested in helping in some manner to contact one of us. Lots of people have continued to volunteer their time.

Thank You!! We will have a list to sign up on for committees you may be interest in, or if you have a special interest in another area. Do you have a background in Veterinary medicine? What about contributing an article for each DR? Are you good with computers or graphic design? How about your accounting skills? Want to help with our audits? Are you a member living outside the U.S.? How about sending in an article on Dutch in your neck of the woods? We have a great group of people that have agreed to help on committees and would love to bring in some fresh blood and ideas. You learn more about the club and get to know your fellow Dutch friends all the more.

Voting members will be finding ballots in their mailboxes. The Constitution and Bylaws are up for voting so take the time to read through them. It is important that ballots be returned by the date noted. Please take the time to vote! Have your vote count by filling it out and placing it in the mail!

Best wishes with your Dutch and hope your heart skips a beat when you see the markings on the babies in the boxes!

I hope by the time you receive this issue of the Dutch Reporter cooler temperatures will have arrived ushering in fall. This summer has been one of the hottest in the Midwest in decades. We went from a cold wet spring to a hot humid summer over night. Our rabbitry is well ventilated but poorly insulated so it made it very difficult to keep the animals cool.

The ADRC 2011 Ballots went out the first week of August. The President and two of our directors were unopposed but we did have two individuals running to represent district one. The ballot also included a vote for our new Constitution and By-Laws. I hope each of you reviewed the proposed Constitution and By-laws which was published in the spring issue of the Dutch Reporter before voting on such an important issue.

I'd like to thank Scott Williamson for the Scholarship Challenge he put forth in the last Dutch Reporter. The challenge was issued as a way to raise funds for the Scholarship Account. Scott sent me a check for \$2,000.00 which I've deposited in an interest-earning account. Any youth member or specialty club can donate funds to the scholarship endowment and it will be matched with 10% of its value being issued from the \$2,000.00. This is a great way for our club to build the scholarship fund!

Sellers need to be reminded of their obligation to the buyer and too follow simple ethics. No matter if you're a breeder in Canada or the USA, we must treat everyone fairly and with respect.

The ARBA Convention will be here in a few weeks and I know Val and Kelli Slack are hard at work getting ready. Please make sure you read

Luckily, I have 24" chicken house fans in my rabbitries which are wired to thermostats and cyclers which can be set. Cyclers are really more important in winter when building is closed up. This brings in fresh air as needed. Being located in "Poultry Country", I also can use fogger nozzles to produce a very fine mist of water in front of fans. This really works great to provide cool air through the building. Fogging nozzles can be bought in different sizes, to provide needed moisture without wetting everything. Another option I have used in the past was to run an oscillating lawn sprinkler on the rabbitry roof to help cool the building.

Before we know it, summer will be behind us and our thoughts will be geared towards the ARBA Convention in Indianapolis. Fall shows will also start to be in full swing by the end of September. Juniors for the Convention should be about three months old now. I try to always breed my Juniors for the NDS and Convention so that they are just a few days away from being seniors when shown at these two shows. This was one of the first pieces of advice that long-time Dutch breeder Wayne MacKinnon of Massachusetts told me to do for National Shows.

In closing, I will again remind you to make sure the shows being entered this fall have a sanction for Dutch prior to the show. See you at the Fall Shows.

The litter of blacks was able to jump out of their nest box and they survived. It seems that if I loose a litter it's usually blues that die for one reason or another.

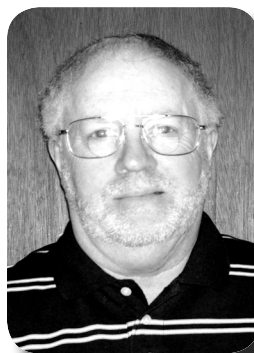

I keep a digital temperature gauge in the barn and it's been in the high 80's to low 90's each day for the last two weeks. Hopefully it will cool down by the end of the month, if not I will probably delay breeding until it turns cooler to insure the bucks are fertile and ready to go.

It won't be long until the fall shows start up here in Ohio and Indiana, so take this opportunity to get your Dutch on the show table during September, and October and let us know how you do.

I hope your young jrs are looking good and growing well for the convention. I wish everyone luck and a safe trip to Indy.

**I**hope everyone had the opportunity to attend a few Fair shows this Summer, and didn't suffer the tremendous heat spell we experienced here in the midwest. A couple of the shows I judged were simply unbearable, and trying to pose the rabbits was like trying to make a water balloon stand erect.

Our animals withstood the heat, although there were a couple of times it was questionable. Fans, cold water, and staying out of the rabbitry so they didn't move around a lot all helped them get through the very hot days.

In the Spring we were fortunate enough to have several litters, but it appears we are in the "ugly" stage of the cycle as far as getting some decent show prospects. Since Norma and I have been raising Dutch (nearly 40 years now), it seems we go in cycles. We will have a stretch where we may get only a handful of show rabbits out of quite a few litters, then we go through stretches where we may get several



show prospects out of just one litter. The latter seems to be the outside part of the cycle, not coming as often as the other part. We keep on plugging though, as all Dutch breeders must do. Having a smaller rabbitry (we have only 28 holes) is a handicap also, as raising good Dutch is a game of numbers. The more you can raise, the better your odds. Having several of those 28 holes dedicated to a few Mini Rex and now a few Nertherland Dwarfs, the numbers game is not feasible for us. We have to just work with the space we have for the Dutch, and cull extremely close. Trying to keep does bred for those show prospects limits the number of animals we may have to enter at a show. No matter what though, we enjoy the Dutch and are happy with what we can have to work with.

Indianapolis is just around the corner, and the ADRC Board will be meeting for our bi-annual meeting. If there is any topic you wish to have discussed, please do not hesitate to contact me (or any of the other officers of the ADRC), and make your concerns known. We are unable to address issues which you may want, without knowing what they are. The ADRC Board is comprised of a great "balance" of personnel, and we have a lot of experienced members representing the membership, as well as the organization. We have the insight and foresight to view matters from several angles, thus are able to offer various options regarding concerns, ideas, or suggestions. At times compromise is the best solution, taking several postive pieces from different views and suggestions, and making the end result best for all concerned.

The weather here in the Midwest has been very difficult. We had a cold, wet spring that transitioned into a hot, dry summer. We

have run our air conditioner more this year than any other. Unfortunately, we do not have air conditioning in our rabbit barn. We have kept the fans going 24/7, which is unusual for our barn as Michigan nights typically cool down. Our promising group of juniors for Convention has some of the longest ears I have seen, Kristy says she can see them growing daily. Unlike some breeders I have heard from, we have not lost any rabbits due to the heat, but it also happened that we had no litters born in July. The pregnant does and newly born kits seem to suffer from heat stress the most. The downside is that we want to breed now and I have doubts that there are any fertile bucks in the barn due to weeks of high temperatures. I compared last July with this July in temperatures in Charlotte Michigan with the following results:

July 2010		July 2011	
Over 90 degrees	1	Over 90 degrees	10
85-89 degrees	9	85-89 degrees	14
80-84 degrees	14	80-84 degrees	5
75-79 degrees	5	75-79 degrees	2
Under 74 degrees	2	Under 74 degrees	0

Twenty-four days above 85 degrees compared to ten days last year. And even when I was up at 5:00 am the temperature was often close to 80 degrees before the sun was even up. And it is not just Michigan; I have heard numerous laments across the Midwest of the terrible heat problems. This leads me into my next topic.

I have started a new survey on the American Dutch Rabbit Club website called "What do you Think?" A series of questions will be listed on the website on various topics concerning our rabbits that will change each quarter. A selection of the answers will be printed in the Dutch Reporter

Our Dutch history is rich with the input, accomplishments and hard work of several people that helped the club be what it is today. The

following group of people was compiled by Stan Goeglein and his Hall of Fame Committee with the intent of recognizing their part in our past. The ADRC Board felt the best way to honor them was to have a separate group outside the Hall of Fame. They are the first to join this new group that is to be named in the near future from suggestions directly coming from our membership. In the future, other ADRC members may be added to this group also. A brief bio is included with each member. Please note that the letter "D" denotes they are deceased.

#### **George Bayliss, (D), Hayward, California**

Former ADRC President 1954 to 1963 and Vice President in 1952. A longtime member of the Dutch Club. First to have imported Dutch on the West Coast. Showed in the United Kingdom and U.S.

#### **Don Lovejoy, (D), Fresno, California**

Former Dutch Club Director serving from 1965 to 1982, longtime member, had many national wins over a long period of time, also a well respected writer of numerous articles on the Dutch rabbit.

#### **Bill Summers, Colorado Springs, Colorado**

Served as President 1964 thru 1968 and Director of Dutch Club in 1962 & 1963. Longtime member and supporter and writer. Breeder of several National Show winners.

#### **Mrs. Lyle Neubauer, (D), Pueblo, Colorado**

Former Dutch Club Secretary-Treasurer in 1951 & 1952 and supporter. One of the first women

showing Dutch extensively.

#### **John Nelson, (D), Crete, Illinois**

Longtime A.D.R.C. member, master showman. Many National Show winners, known for putting excellent fur on his Dutch. BOB NDS in 1978 & 1989.

#### **Al Seeman, (D), Joliet, Illinois**

Longtime A.D.R.C. member. Bred excellent Dutch, bred National Show winners. BOB NDS in 1974 & 1975. Had some excellent B.I.S. rabbits.

#### **Ancel Beaver, (D), Indianapolis, Indiana**

Vice-President of the ADRC in 1944 & 1945 and President in 1946 & 1947 and director in 1948. One of the founders and most successful members of A.D.R.C. He bred the B.O.B. Dutch at three consecutive National Dutch Shows, all being black senior bucks. BOB 1945, 1951 and BOS in 1946. He was the originator of the description, "toy type Dutch of the future".

#### **Tom Shufflebotham, (D), Valparaiso, Indiana**

Longtime Dutch Club member and served 16 years as director of the ADRC starting in 1944. One of the founding members when the Club reorganized. Imported all of his original stud of black, blues, and tortoise Dutch from England direct. Had many National Dutch Show and Convention winners. Won BOB at NDS in 1953, 1966 & 1968 also won BOS in 1965, 1972 & 1976. Also, a prolific writer and historian for our Club.

#### **Dr. Terry Reed, D.V.M., (D), Markle, Indiana**

Past President of ARBA and served as a Director of the ADRC from 1989 to 1993. National Dutch Show winner and Sweepstakes winner. Prolific writer on Dutch Rabbits in many publications throughout the world. Lectured on, wrote about, and promoted the Dutch rabbit.

#### **Lowell W. Simonson, (D), Des Moines, Iowa**

Longtime dedicated Dutch member and fancier who won at major shows on the national level for many years. Served one term as director in the ADRC and won BOS at the 1983 ARBA Convention.



**Dale Zentner, (D), LuVerne, Iowa**

Longtime dedicated Dutch member and fancier who won at major shows on the national level for many years.

**Lester & Louise Johnson, (D)  
Halstead, Kansas**

Mr. & Mrs. Johnson were both devoted longtime Dutch Club members, and showed many National Dutch Show winners throughout the country over an extensive period of time. Won BOB at NDS in 1981 and BOS in 1977 and 1983.

**Madeleine Tuttle Grables, (D)  
Pontiac, Michigan**

Served as Secretary-Treasurer of the Dutch Club from 1953 to 1957. Showed and won at National Dutch Shows and was a supporter of the A.D.R.C. for several years.

**Mrs. Jessie Weinhardt, (D),  
Manchester, Michigan**

Served as Secretary-Treasurer of the A.D.R.C. from 1958 to 1970 and worked tirelessly for many years for the betterment of the Club. Showed Dutch all over the country for many years and did well with them.

**Doris Leibel, (D), St. Paul, Minnesota**

Served as Secretary-Treasurer from 1971 to 1974 and DR Editor from 1969 to 1974. Doris also served as a director in 1969 and 1970. She was also the first woman to judge our Dutch at the National level. Ms. Leibel was a longtime member and exhibitor of Dutch in our A.D.R.C.

**Mr. John Furrier, (D), St. Louis, Missouri**

He was one of the early presidents of the A.D.R.C. in the mid-1930's and again in the 1940's, and was involved with reorganization of the club. Worked with Mr. Sauer and Mr. Bernhardt, with all three being from St. Louis. He helped in moving the club forward to what we now have today. He was a dedicated fancier and longtime member.

\*I do have record of John serving as President starting in 1937

**Mr. R. L. Souers, (D), St. Louis, Missouri**

Mr. Souers was Secretary-Treasurer of the A.D.R.C. from 1944 to 1949 and served as the DR Editor from 1945 to 1949. During the period when the first two of our Club's Guidebooks were published. It was also the time of the publishing of the first Dutch Reporter Magazine. This was a monthly publication at that time. Also, the first Dutch Club Sweepstakes transpired during this period. This period was from approximately 1944 through the early 1950's and was, indeed, a busy, industrious period for this Dutch Club supporter, member and also Club President.

**Mr. R.J. Dick Burnhardt, (D)  
St. Louis, Missouri**

Mr. Burnhardt was a longtime A.D.R.C. member and served as Director from 1945 to 1949 and again in 1952 & 1953. He was a writer and art illustrator who worked side-by-side with Mr. Souers in composing our first three Guidebooks that we still enjoy today. He also did the original photo cuts and layout work for these early Guidebooks.

**A.E. "Gillie" Gilbert, (D)  
Syracuse, New York**

Former long time member, Director and one of the original founders of the reorganization group of the A.D.R.C. He was an authority on all aspects of Tortoise Dutch breeding, an author and a very successful showman. \*Did serve as a Director of the ADRC.

**Charles Lewis, (D), Roslyn Heights, New York**

Longtime A.D.R.C. member, officer in many capacities. He imported the first chocolate Dutch into this country in 1925. He was one of the first importers to show English Dutch at our national shows very successfully. He did much writing on our original Dutch Standards and many other praiseworthy ventures to enhance the Dutch fancy and the A.D.R.C.

\*Records indicate he was a longtime member and served as an officer from 1937 till 1955.



## E.C. Bickley, (D), Sandusky, Ohio

Distinctive Dutch. He was appropriate in describing Bickley's Dutch. They really did all look uniform. He won often in the mid to late 1950's. B.O.B. and display were often his at National Dutch Shows and Conventions. He too was a club officer and longtime member of the A.D.R.C. and was instrumental in forming the Ohio Dutch Club.

\*Served 8 years as an officer of ADRC. Winner of 3 BOB & BOS at NDS.

## Jack Boughton, (D), Chesterland, Ohio

Some of the best black Dutch in the country for several years running were owned and shown by Mr. Boughton. The late 50's and early 60's were dominated by Mr. Boughton with his small stud of black Dutch only. He was also a Dutch Club officer.

\*Served as ADRC VP for 3 years. Winner of 3 NDS during the 1960's.

## A.E. "Pop" Sautters (D), Canton, Ohio

One of the first trailblazers in getting the original A.D.R.C. organized and off and running. He was a club officer in the reorganization of

the club. He was a dedicated Dutch fancier from the 1930', 1940's and 1950's. He was a breeder of fine Dutch for many years.

\*Served as director in the ADRC for 6 years.

## Al Meier, Jr., (D)

### N. Royalton, Ohio and Cowpen, So. Carolina

Areal Dutch fancier, longtime A.D.R.C. member and officer. He was a true scholar of the working Standard of the Dutch rabbit is how you would describe Mr. Meier. He was also a writer who wrote many articles for all our rabbit publications. He had several national wins with his Dutch over the years, also, and was Chairman of the A.R.B.A. Standard Committee for seventeen years.

\*Served two ye the ADRC.



## Jim Blyth, (D), Pittsburgh, PA

Jimmy Blyth would really be considered one of the truly greats in the Dutch rabbit fancy for all times. He was considered one of the finest of Dutch judges and authorities. He wrote many articles, was an A.D.R.C. officer for many years, imported Dutch from England several times to this country and literally raised them most all his life. He was, by profession, the Secretary of the A.R.B.A. for many years.

\*Served as Director for at least 13 years.

# HALL OF FAME APPLICATION PROCESS

1. A nomination form will appear in the Dutch Reporter at least once a year. This nomination application will also be available on the Dutch Website and through the ADRC secretary.
2. The signatures of at least 10 ADRC members in good standing must accompany the nomination.
3. A brief biography of the nominee must be included with the nomination application (The Hall of Fame committee and/or the Board of Directors of ADRC, reserve the right to request more biographical information on the nominee as deemed necessary).
4. Nominee must have been a continuous adult member in good standing with ADRC for at least 15 years.
5. A Hall of Fame nominee can be of any age or sex as long as the nominee has met the membership requirements for nomination.
6. The completed nomination form is to be returned to ADRC secretary for verification.
7. The verified nomination form will then be forwarded to the Hall of Fame committee chairperson and committee members for recommendation.

## VOTING PROCEDURE

1. The Hall of Fame committee will vote to recommend inductees to the Board of Directors of the ADRC. A 2/3 majority rule will be used in the recommendation process.
2. A current committee member or board member is not eligible to cast a vote if the nominee is him/herself.
3. The number of years of continuous adult membership service to the ADRC, showmanship record, promotion of the Dutch Rabbit and The American Dutch Rabbit Club are considerations in the voting.
4. The Board of Directors may reject any nominee they feel does not meet the criteria to be inducted and must vote to accept or reject the nomination using a 2/3 majority rule.
5. All nominations not voted on favorably may be resubmitted annually for reconsideration.

6. At least two inductions are preferred each year, but their will be no limit on the number of inductions to be awarded including those inductions awarded posthumously.
7. A.) All nomination applications must be received by the secretary of the ADRC no later than January 15th of each year to be considered for induction the following spring at the National Dutch Show.  
B.) January 15th the secretary shall forward all recommendations to the Hall of Fame committee chairperson and committee members for consideration.  
C.) February 1st, recommendations and any concerns for the HOF committee are to be submitted to the ADRC President and Secretary. This will be forwarded the Board of Directors for discussion and vote.  
D.) March 1st, the secretary will inform the Board of Directors and the HOF committee chairperson of the voting results and will make arrangements for the awards to be ordered.  
E.) The candidates selected to be inducted into the Hall of Fame will be presented the award at the National Dutch show banquet.

## INDUCTION

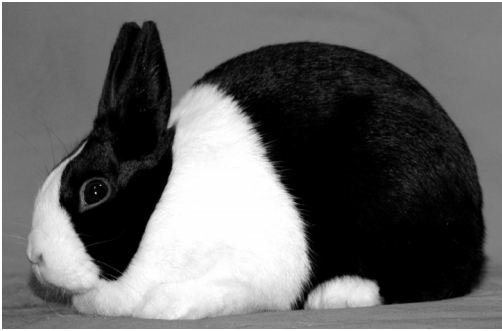
1. Members honored for induction shall have the induction honor presented to them at the National Dutch Show banquet.
2. Induction honoree shall also receive a Lifetime Membership to the ADRC if the inductee has not already achieved that status.
3. Inductees' names shall forever be added to the list of Hall of Fame members published in the Dutch Reporter each year.
4. Inductees names shall forever appear in ADRC Guide Book under: "Hall of Fame Members" each time a Guide Book is published.

What a treat it was to be able to win BOS at the 2011 Open Wisconsin National Dutch Show. It was truly an exciting day. F82, the Senior Black Buck I won with, was also 2nd in his class at the 2010 ARBA Natl's. The making of F82 began in Kansas, when we purchased his sire at the Kansas



NDS in the sellers class. Thanks to Al Gerhart who was willing to enter him in. I remember thinking on my way to Hutchinson Kansas that one thing I didn't need was another black buck. When I go to the NDS, I try to have a plan in place for potential additions to my Dutch herd.

Having arrived early, I had plenty of time to look at some rabbits, and I came across this black buck of Al Gerhart's that was going to be sold in the sellers class. The black buck was M293, and I immediately thought to myself, "I like this buck, I should buy this buck, but I don't need another black buck". So not needing a black buck, I didn't spend too much time looking him over ( but I did get back to his cage a few times just to check him out again). However, being guilty of liking to go through the sellers class to see what's available, I had a chance to look at him again one last time . It was too much. Even though I had no need for another black buck, he was too good to pass up. If the price was right, I was going to try and buy him. His sire is Gerhart's M205, who at the time I purchased him had 18 legs, and his dam was Lape's CD297. So F82 has come from a winning background. Presently F82 has nine legs. He undoubtedly is one of the best Dutch rabbits I have ever raised. For him to show well at 2 different National shows is one of my biggest thrills.

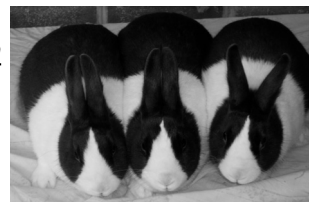

# *Blast from the Past*

Copies of the Old Dutch Reporters are on the ADRC website for future generations to read and enjoy. This column will feature selected articles from our history.

## The Steel Dutch by George A. Townsend

(This article is a reprint from the 1953 edition of the United Kingdom Dutch Rabbit Club yearbook. This was sent to the Dutch Reporter by Earl D. Hord of Colorado.)

I have been asked by our Secretary to write a few lines on the Steel Dutch, and give my readers a few memories of the past which I hope will be of interest.

To the question, "have we lost the correct colour of Steels?" my reply is "yes!" The name "Steel" was given to this variety from its resemblance in undercolour to the metal. Today this resemblance has gone and the undercolour is nearer to brown than blue. The brown shade is much more pronounced on hind feet, the ears and body are much too dark and lacking ticking, and any suggestion of blue has been outbred. You cannot get this blue undercolour without your breeding pair containing a "cross" of blue in either Sire or Dam. To do this was much easier in the dim past than it is today. We then had two acknowledged colours of Dutch, now nearly extinct: the Blue-gray and the Blue-fawn were the colours, and the former the one we used - the mating was black Buck and Blue-Gray doe, and we usually had a Steel or two in the resulting litter.

This is the method I adopted, and so did many of my contemporaries. I started on Steels well over fifty years ago and bred several well-marked exhibits equally ticked all over, including ears and hind feet with a distinct steel undercolor. My stud of bucks had a dash of blue in its make-up - the blue-grays were produced by mating two pale tortoiseshells, or tortoise and pale gray. In those days both of these off colours were recognized by the Club, and about 1903 the Young Dutch Cup was won by a Blue-Gray exhibited by Mr. Plan, of Hanley. A few years later the Club by-rule cut out both these rather unpopular colours. This action, in my opinion,

is the reason for the decline in Steels, and to anyone interested I suggest that if they ever see a Blue-gray doe, to purchase it, and if they breed one by accident they will be lucky and save themselves years of hard work and deep thinking.

The really correct steel is a beautiful rabbit and lasts better than every other colour. This colour is not easy to describe on paper - if, however, you break a rod of steel, the colour at the break is the correct one.

Personally, I should like to see the blue-gray reinstated as an exhibition colour, if only to bring us back to the true Steel. This manner of producing Steels as described was the one used, amongst others, by Ephraim Blakelock of Clockheaton, who produced a string of winning Steels and won the Young Steel Cup in 1924 and 1931 - rabbits that remain in my mind's eye until the present.

Another old friend, and he is still hard at it, is F.G. Perks - once known as the "Steel King". I do not know, however, how he kept the correct Steel colour in his stock.

My subject is a very interesting game indeed, and trying to breed a typical Steel is by no means easy going. I know I enjoyed my struggle to achieve fame with this lovely rabbit. It would be interesting to have my old friend, Mr. E.C. Richardson on the best way to regain the make-up of the ideal Steel - it must put us on to a scientific method of accomplishing our object.

One of the strangest happenings in Steel breeding I know of is that I was shown, by a Leicester fancier - I forget his name - a young Steel that had won a few firsts. After its adult moult it was a very good coloured BLACK and won several further prizes. The reverse, however, is quite common or was in my day.

As a conclusion, don't forget that you have a better chance of breeding a winner if you use a really well-marked buck to a rather heavily marked doe: that was my experience and is, I know the experience of several of the older hands. Don't forget that the saddle was once a "collar" and so called. The saddle has been slipping further and further back for years. The Dutch is a coloured rabbit with white markings and should certainly not be a half-and-halfer.

The Dutch rabbit has figured "large" in my long life - I still have my first prize card - a third only, however. It is dated 1865. I little thought in



those schoolboy days that I should be President of the Club one day and make real friends all over the Country, all interested in the humble bunny, as I was. My life has been made richer by mixing amongst men of all shades of thought and position.

Old men live in the past, and my memories of friends made through the fancy cheer me in the winter of my life.

(Editor's Note: for the benefit of our newer members, Mr. Townsend was a well-known judge over a period of 50 years, often traveling over 7,000 miles to shows in a single year. He was president of the U.K.D.R.C. from 1920 to 1935, and judged every premier show in England, Scotland, Ireland and Wales at different times in his career as a fancier and judge.)

*Scott Braden* from Beach City OH on Purina Show Formula: I have worked in agriculture all my life. Dairy farming, raising sheep, and rabbits. No matter the species of animal Purina has always provided a quality product that is consistent bag after bag.

*Sarah Cleavenger* from Renton WA on Pfau Feed: I was with my previous feed for 8 years, until I had issues with their consistency three years ago (pig food was mixed in and killed several of my rabbits). I tried a couple different feeds for the next year, which I was not happy with any of them, before settling with Pfau's. It's one of the more expensive feeds in my area, as it's the most popular, but I was able to join a group who has it shipped straight from the mill for \$5-10 less per bag.

**John Graybeal** from Anneville PA on Purina Complete: Good basic balanced ration, with sufficient calories to be used as a grower and with moderation, can be used to maintain production stock. But the most important reason I use this is that it is available to me fresh. This is extremely important to me. As a young rabbit raiser (40 years ago) my father (who raised national quality standard Rex) impressed two things on me. In order to obtain and maintain show condition, two things were important. First fresh water. And second, FRESH feed. The fresher the better. I never use feed more than 6 weeks old. Fortunately, I have a source where I can get quantity delivered to the farm, never more than 2 weeks old when delivered. I believe this is the single most important quality in a feed.

**Carolyn Hidalgo** from Albuquerque NM on Manna Pro Sho: It is the best feed I can get in Albuquerque.

**Sue Hill** from Verona WI on ADM Alliance Nutrition Pen Pals: The plant is a mere 10 minutes from my home so I can get food that is so freshly milled that it's still warm in the bag when I pick it up. I had heard several people have had good luck with it, so after moving and having challenges in finding a good feed at a reasonable cost, I decided to give it a try. That has been 10 years and I don't care to think of using any other feed. Over the course of raising rabbits, I've used Purina, Nutrena, Land O Lakes, Manna Pro and Heinhold, and I have liked this feed better than any others.

**Kandy Reif** from Clarence IA on Nutrena Naturewise Premium: We were Manna Pro dealers for about a year & used Manna for 2 years. For the past few months we were getting a lot of fines in the feed (had to sift every scoopful). The pellets didn't smell like they use to when we first were using it. I contacted the president of the company & got a few different excuses for the poor quality. My rabbits were producing well through all this but they seemed to be losing body condition & does were thin after weaning. We switched to Nutrena after a nice talk with Mike Avesing about Nutrena & so far I am happy with it. I do add a conditioner to the show rabbits feed.

**James Rydell** from Vermillion SD on Purina Show: Because of the success I have had when I've fed it. This is the third time I have gone back

to Purina. The times I have switched were for convenience of purchase, and or cost of product. When I've switched to the other products, which was several times, I always ended up with reproductive problems. The major issues were does having difficulty giving birth, deformed babies associated with Vit A deficiency, and poor breeding by both bucks and does. Rabbits also seemed starved for fiber. Continuous molting was another issue. Most rabbits eventually became too fat on the other products, which contributed to more breeding problems, and loss of productive animals, and having to cull good rabbits, way too early, and limiting your ability to improve your line of rabbits.

### **\*\* What do you like about the product?**

**Sarah Cleavenger** on Pfau Feed: Since I get it straight from the mill, I like that it's always milled the week that I get it, so I know it's fresh. It's the greenest feed I've ever seen, and the rabbits love it. When I first started it, I had a few off feed, and they immediately started eating again when given Pfau's. I also like the fact that if there are any concerns with the feed, the owner is right on top of things. He's even on our area's online group, and watches for any talk about his feed.

**John Graybeal** Anneville PA on Purina Complete: As mentioned above, I highly value that I can obtain this feed fresh. I also value the calories in it that come from corn. Unlike most people today, I am not afraid to feed a little corn. I remember the day when our rabbits were fed corn right off of the cob, from my grandfather's fields. I seriously doubt that corn is really the problem some people seem to think it is.

**Sue Hill** from Verona WI on ADM Alliance Nutrition Pen Pals: It puts good flesh on my animals, always smells fresh, and I can easily pick it up when I need it. My growth rate on litters is super. Babies readily start eating pellets at an early age and are plump butterballs in no time. Does come back from raising a litter quickly. Coats are slick and I rarely have trouble with a new bunny switching to my feed when they come to my barn.

**Kristy Hume** from Charlotte Mi on Manna Pro Sho: Since switching to Manna Pro SHO, I have noticed that most of my young juniors are developing quality coats at a younger age.



**\*\* What do you dislike about the product?**

**David AuBuchon** from Leadwood MO on Purina Fiber Three: The price keeps going up. I'm sure it's the same for others but I am paying over \$15/bag for a 50 lb. bag. It can get very expensive. I feel sorry for breeders on limited budgets as it can make things difficult for them.

**Erik Bengtson** from Zumbrota MN on Purina Professional: Purina Professional alone does not give the rabbits an ideal finished coat, a few top dressings are needed to push the coat finish to where I want it. And of course I dislike the cost of the feed. Purina is one of the more expensive products.

**Kristy Hume** from Charlotte Mi on Manna Pro Sho: I am not happy with the amount of fines I find in the bags, and the inconsistency in the product bag-to-bag. Sometimes I even find whole kernels of corn in the feed when corn is not even one of the ingredients. I understand that they produce other feeds in the same equipment, but the amount of unwanted stuff I am finding in my feed seems excessive.

**Barbara Kerdeman** from Manheim PA on Purina Fibre 3 & Complete: Don't like when you get to the end of the bag and have so much feed dust. Update: This is an update from the other day when I did this survey. I have had a problem with mold in my feed. We are trying to get this resolved. There have been no further updates.

**Wesley Nelson** from Treynor IA on Pen Pals Pro 16: periodically you get fines in a bag, but those are usually in an older bag.

**\*\* If you could improve your feed, what would you suggest?**

**David AuBuchon** from Leadwood MO on Purina Fiber Three: I'm fine with the feed but I think Purina should work with its store owner/distributors as many of them don't have a clue about what quality customer service is. When you are "special ordering" feed you aren't doing the customer a favor by ordering it.....they are doing you a favor by frequenting your business. That's a fairly simple business principle that many store owners don't seem to get.

**Scott Braden** from Beach City OH on Purina Show Formula: I would like to see it cold pelleted instead of heat pelleted. When feedstuffs are heated some of the nutrients are lost or become unavailable to the animal. Lowering the cost would also be great, but not at the expense of quality.

**Samantha Hahn** from Owosso MI on Kent 17% protein rabbit formula: Well, I wouldn't mind water-proof bags, because sometimes the feed can get wet, but that is just a preference.

**Stacey Sauter** from York PA on Manna Pro: more research into bigger litter sizes...we went from 9 to 13 on Purina, to 3 to 5 on Manna Pro.

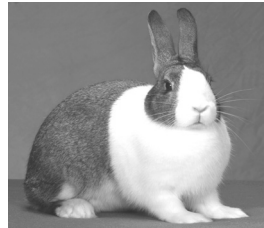

PROCEDURES FOR YOUTH SCHOLARSHIP APPLICANTS

1. All applications must be submitted on forms obtained from Scholarship Committee member. *Computer forms will not be accepted unless in original format.*
2. Applicants must have held continuous ADRC membership for at least three (3) years preceding application for scholarship.
3. Applicants are eligible to apply only if they are a high school graduate under the age of 21 and currently have at least 12 credit hours of college education.
4. Applicants must have completed high school with a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.00 (unweighted) on a grade scale of 4.00, and have been in the top 50% of graduating class.
5. Home schooled applicants are eligible, but must submit SAT or ACT scores, and a letter of recommendation from a person outside the immediate family.
6. All applications must include a complete High School and College transcript.
7. Scholarship proceeds may be used to further education at any accredited four (4) year college, two (2) year college, vocational, or technical school.
8. Scholarships will be paid to the member and school upon receipt of confirmation of college enrollment.
9. All applications must be postmarked by ***March 15<sup>th</sup> of application year*** and returned to the ADRC Youth Scholarship Foundation.
10. Applicants are only eligible to win scholarship one time.

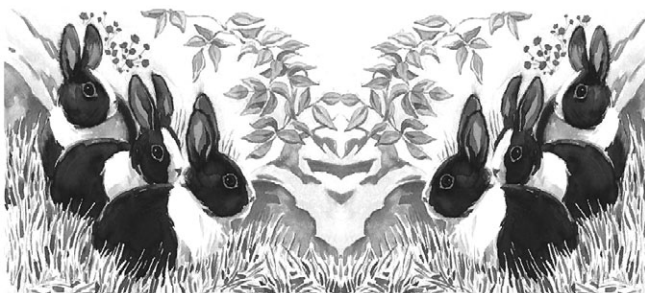

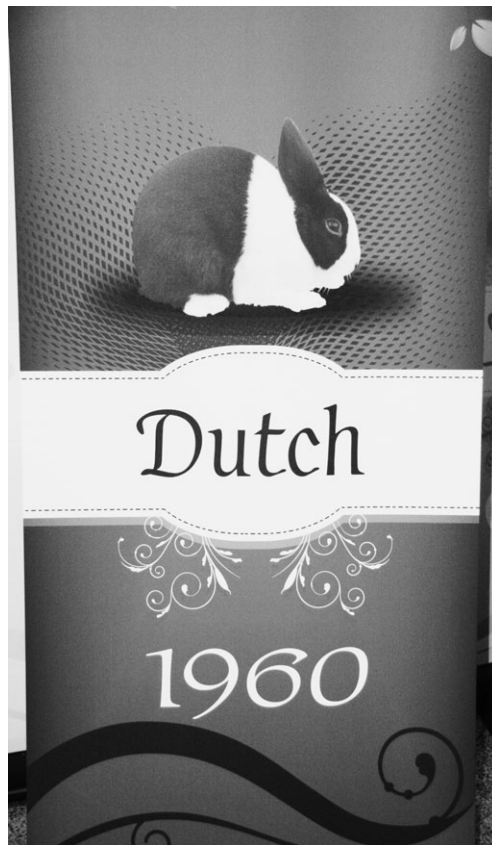
