





President's MESSAGE

hope your Dutch have fared well in this summer's heat. I feel for those of you who have been baking in the 100 degree heat. We rarely have to deal with those high of temperatures, but we do get the high humidity.

Those of you who have tried to email me, my e-mail address in the last DR was incorrect. It has been corrected now.

We have computer programmer working on our sweepstakes program, which if it goes according to plan, should be on line to start the 1999 sweepstakes year. This program will be capable of calculating variety points, Quality Points (Best In Show, 4 class, BOB, and BOS. This will enable us to pick rabbit of the year based on its' show record. We are also having a secretaries program developed to fit the position's needs. It will speed up the processing of sanction information, allow for computer communication between the secretary, and our sweepstakes chair. Our secretary puts in a bunch of time through the year processing not only 700 or so memberships, but around 1400 sanction requests. This is an investment that will improve the efficiency of the secretary and our sweepstakes person. We have had a nice computer donated for our sweepstakes chair to use. We may have to look at replacing the club's computer as it does not have the capacity to do what our program will allow The clubs' current system was purchased in 1993, and at the time was pretty modern.

The ARBA Convention is rapidly approaching, and may be here before this issue reaches you. Those of you who will be attending, give the Northwest crew a hand. This is no small job, and they don't have many experienced members to run the show. I will not be attending, but I may be sending some Dutch.

I have been made aware of something that I want to bring in front of the membership. The reason I do so is because this is the type of thing, if left unchecked, could slow or destroy the progress that we have been making in the ADRC. There are a few who supposedly have the impression that the Ohio State Dutch Club is running the ADRC. Those who have this impression are not always, or may have never been to the NDS, and ARBA Convention, nor are they very active in the club. This impression is dead wrong! Yes, I am also the President of the Ohio State Dutch Club, and one of our Directors, Todd Uran, is the Ohio Dutch's Vice-President. When I was elected President, the first thing I did was to appoint someone to replace me as Director of District 1. I wanted someone in this position who was visible, would represent the ADRC well, and would be an asset to the Board. This was an obvious choice. Todd Uran. I also had to appoint someone to another District 1 position as no one ran for the vacant seat. Here it was an obvious choice in Martin Preede of New Jersey. All other officers have been duly elected. The only other appointments that have been made are committee chairman for various committees. They are from; Iowa, Michigan, California, Kansas and Indiana. Last year, we were looking for someone to head up

the development of our next Guidebook, and Todd Uran volunteered for this at one of our semi-annual Board meetings. When looking for people to do jobs for the ADRC, I look for reliability, experience, and someone who will work for the betterment of the Dutch rabbit, and the ADRC! I could care less where they're from. Those who have this impression, should realize that it takes a lot of work from a lot of members to get as many things done as we do. If some of our leaders of the ADRC like to contribute a lot of time and energy to the club, then I'm all for it, regardless of whether they are members of the Ohio Dutch, Upper Midwest, Kansas Dutch, or the California Dutch Club. If you want to contribute to the ADRC or its leadership, contribute to the DR, help at the big shows, or run for office. Petty griping about things that you only think, but do not know, are not in the best interests of the ADRC!

The Publicity Committee will be looking at having a Dutch Poster made this next year. This would have all of the varieties color pictures, and possibly views of the Dutch form underneath, as well as close ups of proper tort shading, Gray ring color, depth of color on blacks blues and chocolates, and good steel color. The Mini-Rex club has something similar that looks great.

We will be working on the new Guide Book in the next year, which should be out early in 2000. More will be coming your way on this.

BREEDING DUTCH IN THE WINTER

WINTER BREEDING by Kevin Hooper

inter breeding can be challenging in not only the colder areas, but also in the south. The cooler weather is not the only factor that will influence your breeding success.

The first challenge is to get your does bred. As the days grow shorter, the conception rate will diminish accordingly. Rabbits will breed based on the amount of daylight. The shorter days beginning in September and running through late January will lower the conception rate. You can alleviate this problem by hooking up lights in your rabbitry that are on a timer. I have four, 4' shop lights in my 24' x 32' barn. The timer (about \$13 from any hardware store) turns the lights on at 6:00 AM and they remain on until it gets light out. They will come on again at dusk and remain on until 8:00 PM. This provides the optimum amount of daylight per day for conception. Even with this additional light, the conception rate will not be quite as high as in the spring months.

The challenge then turns to keeping the bunnies alive during and after kindling. I now have an insulated nursery which I can keep above freezing throughout the winter. However, until 2 years ago, I raised them in my unheated, un-insulated barn. My kindling pens were a double row (side by side) of hung cages (only one cage high. I would then put the nest boxes of the four adjacent corners of the pens, so one heat lamp would

warm all four nest boxes. I used a 250 watt inferred bulb, hung about 12"-14" above the top of the box. I use open top boxes so the heat has easy access to the bunnies. I know heat rises, but I did not want the lamps under the pen for fear the doe would urinate into the lamp and cause the bulb to burn out or the circuit to trip. If you do this, you should use the lamps that have a wire guard, so you can fasten the heat lamp to the cage to keep it from moving. Also, the does like the heat too, so you should put a piece of a board in the cage for the doe to sit on. This usually keeps the doe from setting in the box.

In very cold weather, I would take sheets of Styrofoam insulation board, and lean them against each other over the top of the pen (kind a' like a tent). This would aid in holding the heat in. I had good luck with this when we were having a high of only -9 for several days in a row. I have also piled snow around the outside of the barn to help insulate the barn from the wind (if we had any snow).

Lastly, if you have a doe that is not a good milker, she will not raise as many bunnies in the winter. This means you may want to foster some bunnies from larger litters to smaller ones, or possibly cull some of the mismarks or runts at birth.

Most likely, you won't have as much success in the winter as the spring, but the ideas above will help you have more juniors for those spring shows.



WINTER BABIES by Briony Barnes

bout three years ago I got up the courage to try a few winter breedings. After working trial and error (lots of errors!), I finally came up with a system of raising winter babies that has worked well for me.

As you all know, the first step to getting a litter is getting the doe bred I have been very lucky that has never been a problem for me. Of course, now that I said that I only breed my does when they are receptive. The way I tell is to sex them, if they kick their legs it's off to the buck we go. If not, I wait a couple days and check again. It also doesn't hurt to give them a little say in who they are bred to. My girls are a little picky and occasionally one doe absolutely refuses to breed to one buck. Force matings are not the answer. Even if l can get them bred, I have never had forced mating result in a litter. So cross your fingers and try again in the Spring.

Something that has almost always held true in my barn is the doe will kindle around the time of day in which she was bred. So I will breed once when I get home from school (about 3:30, also the warmest part of the day), again an hour later, and a third time about 6 hours later when I amout feeding. This way I can time when they will be born and find them as soon as possible.

Now the doe is bred, pregnant, and it is nestbox time. I use a metal nestbox. The bottom layer of bedding is 2-3" of shredded aspen and on top of this I pack the box full of straw. When the doe digs a next out (or I dig one for her if she's the last-minute type) I will add a handful of a fibery stuff called "Litter Saver". I am not sure what it is but I got a bag of it from KW Cages and it really works great. The aspen will pack tight and mix well with the fur and litter saver while the straw keeps everything in place, making a nice warm nest. If it is especially cold I will put a couple of folded newspapers under the box to prevent heat from escaping.

Occasionally I will have a doe who does not want to build the next in the box. Depending on temperatures I will either cover the floor of the cage with a few inches of straw or bring her in and induce labor. Giving a doe a shot of oxytocin (or its synthetic form, pitocin) will not do serious damage. In order for it to cause labor there have to be other hormones present that are waiting for that kick of oxytocin to start labor. If she isn't ready, she won't kindle. I give 0.1 cc to induce labor and 0.05 to help with milk letdown.

As soon as the babies are born and nursed I bring them inside. Newborns do not have the homeostasis (ability to regulate body temperature) to keep them alive outdoors. To keep them in the box I use a piece of netting (the stufftutus are made out of) and hold it in place with magnets. The babies stay in the coolest part of the house and go out once a day to nurse. At first they are left out only long enough to eat, but I gradually

increase their time outside. They go out to stay at about two weeks.

I have been able to raise many litters through winter (even snowstorms) using this system. Good luck with all your winter Dutch!

BREEDING BLUE DUTCH

here is no real secret to breeding blues that have good color. There are some ides out there that don't always work. Re member, the obvious is not always what to do in breeding Dutch.

Our Standard calls for a medium Blue, yet most of us strive for the darkest blue possible. Why? I believe it is because it is easy for the nice blue color to fade to a light blue, if the breeder isn't careful. It is also because it is not easy to get the dark blue, so if we're not quite to the dark blue, then we'll be at the medium blue.

Breed blue to blue. Start with animals that have the blue color running all the way down the hair shaft to the skin. If you start with this, you'll have little trouble. These Dutch with the excellent depth of color, will appear darker, as there is no light colored fur beneath the surface to lighten it.

You can breed other colors to blue. I rarely do this as once the blue color is there, then the other colors can do nothing to improve on the blue. Some breeders breed blacks to their blues to darken the color. Unless the black that they are breeding to has: excellent depth of color, or dark blue in its' background, or the blue that is being bred to the black is pretty light, the black will do little if anything to darken the blue.

Developing good color in any variety of Dutch takes a few generations. When you begin seeing the progress and the color darkening, you know that you have done something right. This feeling is much better than if you go out and pay top dollar for the darkest blues that you can find. Plan the development of your Dutch, step by step. Get one aspect such as the color where you want it, then work on something else. You can work on more than one aspect at a time, but plan your progress.





REPORT FROM THE ADRC STANDARD'S COMMITTEE

The following is a continuation of a report from the last Dutch Reporter. Please refer to the *April/May/June Dutch Reporter* page 6 for more information.

For starters there is one additional comment for question #2 that read: Give us two sentences that are very descriptive of the correct color of the "gray" variety to be included in the Standard of Perfection.

"An agouti pattern with a minimum of 3 distinct color bands, those being slate blue, tan and black-brown with a lighter tan top color. The tan top color should be evenly dispersed with black guard hairs to create an overall agouti appearance to the coat."

In addition please read on for the rest of the story.

The description of a gray Dutch has been worked and re-worked for over 40 years. **The Dutch Reporter**, printed in 1958 offered several articles detailing the correct color of the "gray" Dutch.

When I undertook this project as a member of the ADRC Standards Committee, I believed we had a problem educating our judges, especially the older judges. As you read the descriptions, notice how different we, the breeders see the same rabbit. I attempted to capitalize the overall descriptive terms. Notice how many call the color DARK, MEDIUM or LIGHT with ticking of jet black or tan. Some of the descriptions are lengthy while others are just what I ask for — two sentences; a mental picture for our breeders and judges to use. I question if we have not overloaded our judges with unnecessary words to describe our "gray" Dutch. Is our wordiness demanding more time of the judge than he is

allowed as he sorts through 200 - 250 rabbits at a show?

My proposal to the ADRC Standards committee is continue to call the agouti variety of the Dutch — "BROWN GRAY", and shorten our description to read "Surface color light brown with black ticking. A chestnut agouti coat with distinctive bands of color". While those polled vote to change back to "Gray", it appears the term "BROWN GRAY" more closely describes the color the majority are raising. Notice how many describe the surface color with these terms — tan, caramel, sandy, light colored, and light brown. Another five years of the same name could unify both our judges and breeders so that all of us are looking for a sandy colored rabbit with black ticking.

We have fought this battle for many years. I am hoping by submitting a simpler, more open description, it will allow for breeder satisfaction and give our judges room to interrupt the color which is only worth 10 points presently. Less points for color could ease the dispute gray breeders have over correct color, whereby they could spend more time on developing better marked & typed animals.

I realize this is a big change from our last entry in the Standard of Perfection but I ask each of you to close your eyes and just listen to the words in those two sentences. Picture this — 'SURFACE COLOR LIGHT BROWN WITH BLACK TICKING. A CHESTNUT AGOUTI COAT WITH DISTINCTIVE BANDS OF COLOR."




ow many times have you found a breeder who has rabbits that you feel would improve your lines? We all know rabbits in the Spring are in high demand. Spring is probably the only time of year that any breeder of rabbits can pay his/her feed bill from rabbit sales.

When is the best time to buy excellent breeding stock? Most breeders raise rabbits for two major shows — the A.R.B.A. Convention in the Fall and the National Dutch Show in the Spring. Since Spring is the easiest time to get litters, many rabbits are born from March to May. Those litters fill the barn during June, July and August.
