Hope 1992 is the best yet for you.

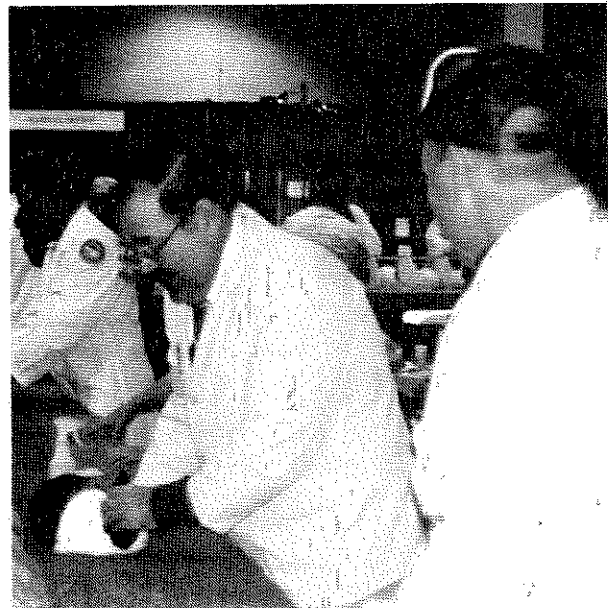
DISTRICT II

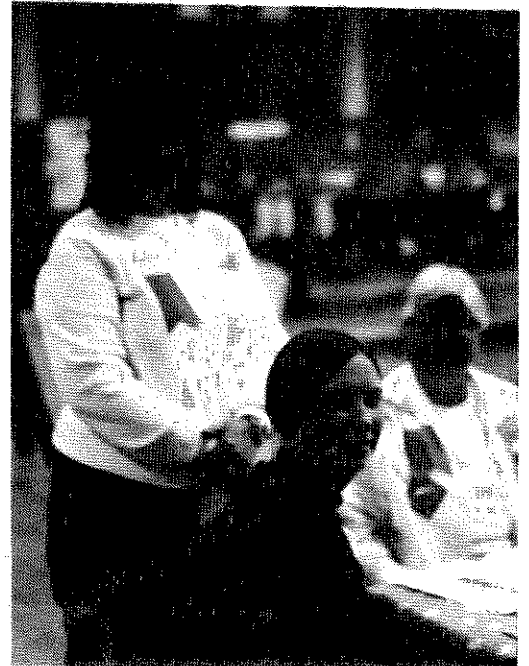

MAKING A FIRST AID

KIT FOR RABBITS

Here are the things I find useful in a first aid kit.

- 1 - Vicks Vapor Rub - good for treatment of colds and snuffles.
- 2 - Hydrogen Peroxide - good for minor cuts.
- 3 - Boric Acid - very good eye wash.
- 4 - Mineral Oil - for treatment and control of ear mites.
- 5 - First Aid Spray - good for vent disease and cuts.
- 6 - Q-tips, cotton balls, and an eye dropper - good for miscellaneous uses.

This whole kit can be put together for around \$10.00, which is a small price to pay if compared to the prices of some rabbit medications sold commercially.

MINUTES OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTOR'S
MEETING; 1991 ARBA CONVENTION
POMONA, CALIFORNIA 11/17/91

The ADRC Board of Director's meeting was called to order by President Carlton at 8PM. Director Schettler made a motion that we dispense with the reading of the minutes from the last Board of Director's meeting as they were published in a Dutch Reporter. The motion was seconded by Director Christ. MC

The Treasurer's Report was read and accepted with a motion by Director Gehr and seconded by Vice-President Reid. MC

ROLL CALL: Present were:

PRESIDENT CARLTON; VICE-PRESIDENT REID; DIRECTORS GEHR; SCHETTLER AND CHRIST; SECRETARY-TREASURER HART.

Absent were:

DIRECTORS MULLINAX; REED; PUGH;
WIREMAN; PARMER AND MULLINAX.

OFFICER'S REPORTS:

Secretary Hart stated that Dutch appeared to be up a little in her area and the quality was improving. It was also noted that the office has received many compliments and thank yous on the return of the variety ribbons from the ADRC.

Director Gehr echoed Secretary Hart's report also stating that Dutch seemed to be up in general with more youth showing in many areas. He stated that he was fortunate to be asked to judge an All Dutch Show in New York recently where the Dutch were very good and the numbers were up.

Director Schettler noted that everything in her area was geared towards the '91 ARBA Convention. Director Schettler stated that the ADRC luncheon was set for Tuesday at the Shilo Inn Restaurant. The General Membership meeting will immediately follow the luncheon. At that time, a motion was made by Director Gehr and seconded by Director Christ that the ADRC furnish luncheon tickets to the judges. MC. He stated that it would be nice to start thinking about the ADRC giving the judges a small token in appreciation for their services. Some clubs give a pen,

a mug or some other form of gift.

Director Christ gave a report stating that it appears that only Chuck and Winton Carlton are the only two showing Dutch in that area. He said there are a few youth once in awhile but there seems to be no consistency.

Vice-President Reid noted that there are no Dutch in the Dallas - Fort Worth area. He said that he has given rabbits to a potential Dutch breeder but so far they are not showing. Occasionally a breeder or two will come up from the Houston area. Vice-President Reid went to a couple of night shows in Oklahoma and Texas that only had about twelve Dutch shown. He said that the quality of what was seen was in poor shape.

President Carlton says that New Mexico has a few Dutch with quite a few youth breeders. He said that some more are beginning to become involved. He said that there are about 35-40 animals shown but about 25 are usually exhibited by himself. He stated that the last time he was in Colorado, there were only about three Dutch shown. There are a few shown in Utah, about 10-20, but the Dutch are down.

Director Wireman sent a note to the Board stating that there were a lot of youth in his area showing Dutch. He also commented that he did not want to see the ADRC raise dues to accommodate paying the judges at the NDS. He has already got the Dutch motel headquarters lined up for the 1992 ARBA Convention in Columbus, Ohio.

The Butlers, PUBLICITY CHAIRPERSONS, sent notice that the Roadrunner Dutch Club would be in charge of the Dutch booth at this Convention. He has the booth space booked for the Columbus convention at the present time. Their publicity financial report was read at that time and a motion to accept it was made by Director Gehr and seconded by Vice-President Reid. MC

The NDS choices by ballot for the 1993 show is: #1 Glen Carr. Glen will be asked to judge with Dick Gehr as a standby according to the entry numbers. Winton Carlton has agreed to do the youth honors.

The ADRC Board will ask Jack Wireman and the Ohio Dutch breeders to handle the breed specials and chairperson duties for the Ohio Convention.

The ADRC Board expressed their utmost 'THANKS' to Jill Dobson for the fantastic job she did on the awards for this show. They also wish to thank the California Dutch people for all of their hard work in putting on the Dutch portion of this Convention and Jim & Fran Schettler for all of their hard work and 'DEDICATION'.

NEW BUSINESS:

The ADRC will attempt to try and implement some action to assist in airline transportation accepting rabbits. It is the objective to try and obtain some type of reference letter directly from the airlines to avoid problems at the counters when traveling.

There was some discussion on possible sweepstakes awards for 11-20 in the open division and 6-10 in the youth. Director Gehr is to check on possible certificates and their cost.

The ADRC Board will check the feasibility of allowing 25% of the ADRC proceeds from the Seller's Class from the ARBA Conventions and National Dutch Shows to be used for specials at each ARBA Convention. The ADRC allotment at the present time is \$150.00 for open and \$50.00 for youth specials. Without donations, it's almost impossible to present ample and suitable awards for these shows.

There was a motion made by Director Gehr and seconded by Director Schettler that the ADRC reimburse the youth sweepstakes person \$1.00 for each show typed for the DR. This will equal what we now allot the open sweepstakes person since the job entails the same amount of work.

Being no further business, a motion to adjourn was made by Vice-President Reid and seconded by Director Christ. MC

THE 1991 AMERICAN RABBIT BREEDERS ASSOCIATION
NATIONAL CONVENTION DUTCH SHOW

I want to take this opportunity to thank all of the Dutch breeders, members of the American Dutch Club and the 1991 convention committee for allowing me the opportunity to judge the Dutch at the 1991 ARBA National Convention. The entire convention committee should be complimented on an outstanding show. Everything possible was done to see that everyone enjoyed themselves. The only negative part of the convention was the amount of traffic and this was nothing the local natives of the area could control in any manner. Those individuals that were in charge of the Dutch show put forth tremendous effort to see that all the Dutch breeders were accommodated in any way possible and to allow for an excellent Dutch show. These individuals are to be congratulated and complemented for all their efforts. Due to my recent physical impairment, it was indeed the "greatest" honor just to be present and be able to judge the Dutch with the honorable Larry Bengston.

It is always extremely interesting to evaluate exhibits at national shows; particularly breeds one has been associated with for a long period of time and has a tremendous interest. This allows one to reflect upon the trends within the breed and within individual varieties over the years. I had the following impressions of the different varieties as it relates to the breeds accomplishments and the need for the future as I judged the Dutch at the 1991 ARBA National Convention.

The overall quality of the Blacks I judges was extremely impressive. I was impressed with the head shape on the majority of the Blacks and the depth in the overall quality in the junior doe class. It is my opinion that the overall head type, ears and length of body has improved greatly over the past few years; but, I do have concern over the overall roundness and fullness of the hindquarter. The general trend of the length of fur is very impressive in the Blacks as it enhances the crispness of the markings. There were only a very few of the animals that exhibited the longer type fur that has been common in the Dutch breed in the past.

There were some excellent quality Blues; but, the quality did not extend as deep in the class as one would have anticipated. There appeared to be a very wide variation of the color and the possible tendency of some of the Blues becoming extremely light.

There were some extremely nice Chocolate Dutch present; but, again, the quality did not extend down in the classes as one would have anticipated and it appeared to me that many of the Chocolates lacked the good depth of color on the hair shaft. Of course, as usual, the surface color varied considerably due to the various condition of the individual rabbits.


I was very impressed with the overall surface color of the Tortoise variety as well as the type; however, there still appears to be little bit of a problem with the overall balance of head and ear type with the improved bodies. There is a situation in the Tortoise variety that gives me great concern. Even though there is absolutely no points allotted to the disposition of the animal, it appeared that there were many animals in the Tortoise variety that were just down right "aggressive". This did not appear to be due to individuals specific irritation; but, there were just many animals in the Tortoise variety that showed aggression that was just natural. It is very difficult for any individual to evaluate the quality of a specimen of any variety when they will not pose and have this aggressive attitude.

There were other situations in other varieties that had individuals that were difficult to pose; but, it was anticipated that these were individual situations where the rabbits were frightened or nervous and it did not appear to be excessive throughout the variety like it was in the Tortoise variety.

There were some extremely nice Greys and Steels present; but, it is obvious that there is a lack of understanding of the Grey and Steel color description as there was very little consistency of the color in either of the varieties. In talking with the various individuals, there appears to be a tremendous amount of confusion of these two varieties and it is difficult to establish a breeding program until we provide an accurate and distinct color description. This is an area that each should provide input to the Dutch Club's Standard Committee.

I want to complement all the exhibitors at the convention as it was fun and very exciting to evaluate the specimens and we will be looking forward to continued support of a tremendous specialty club.

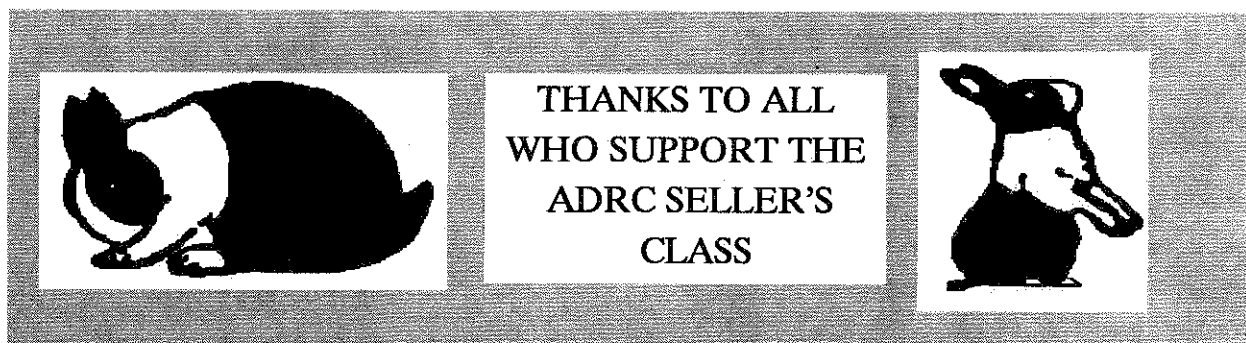

Nelson was known for many things; his 50 year commitment to raising Dutch rabbits (he started raising Dutch in 1941), his "Lord Nelson Strain" (he only outcrossed with a buck 3 times in 50 years), and his tender loving care he gave his rabbits. But of all the things John Nelson represents to the American Dutch Rabbit Club, his most unforgettable and memorable quality was his passion for finishing off his best marked and best typed rabbit with the highest quality of fur. This is what John strived for, and as you will see in the list below, he was quite successful at it for many years.

Evolution of a Breed

Long ears, narrow head, long stops, poor type, fair color, these are some of the remarks you hear when the judge is doing a class of the Tortoise Dutch rabbits.

These are the "general mill of the run" Tortoise of yesterday and today.

One breeder states "but how do I get good Tortoise without paying a small fortune for a good trio?" (Some people are funny, they will pay \$100 to \$300 for a dog or cat for a house pet but think it outrageous to pay \$50 for a good rabbit for show and breeding.)

There is one sure way to get good Tortoise and that is to buy them.

The only other way is to buy a trio of the best you can afford and line breed. This is no guarantee but it is the best method known today.

Below are pictured some of our



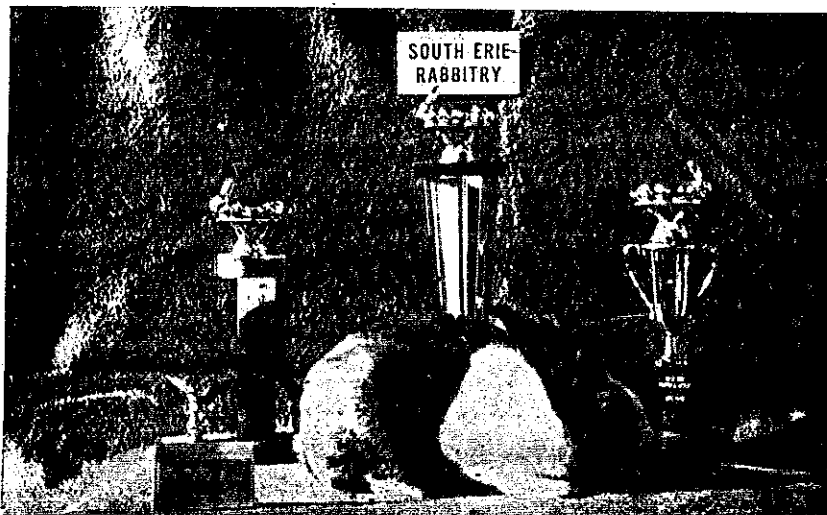
Tortoise Dutch of seven years ago—Zimmerley's Gee (doe).

Now then comes the evolution of the Tortoise. Seven years of selective line breeding, record keeping and the most

critical culling has developed the famous "South Erie" Tortoise of today. Bred to the ARBA standard of perfection.

Short cobby type, bright orange blending into smoky-blue shading over the rump, senior weight of four and one half pounds. This brings up a point of why so many breeders are looking for three and one half pound senior Dutch when the standard calls for four and one half pounds? A three and one half pound senior Dutch does not mean that it will produce a three and one half pound or even a four and one half pound rabbit, for in the background of the pedigree there may have been five and one half and even six pound Dutch. A rabbit can only produce what his background has been. So let us say we want a constant background weight of four and one fourth to four and one half pound rabbits. If you have this in both the bucks and our juniors' ancestors are assume they will produce a four and one half pound senior rabbit.

Now for a glance at "South Erie's" show record, averaging 15 shows a year:

The rabbitry consists of 40 holes. Fifteen breeding does and six stud bucks and our juniors ancestors are grand champions back through six generations.

The following is good sound advice for beginners. Although it was written with Dutch in mind, it can be adapted to any other breed of rabbit.

Selecting Your Color

There are six recognized colors of Dutch for you to choose from. Black, blue, chocolate, tortoise, gray and steel gray.

Getting Ready For Your Rabbits

First you must decide on a place for your rabbitry. If your rabbits are to be kept outdoors they will have to be protected from the hot summer sun and the cold winter wind and snow. Also, you will need a fence around your rabbitry to keep out running dogs.

Having decided on your location, you are ready to build your hutches. If you start with a trio of rabbits you will need a hutch for the buck and a hutch for each doe. You will need four to eight hutches for the young you will keep from their first litters. Your hutches can be one, two or three high depending on how tall you are, you don't want the hutches so high that you won't be able to clean them easily. Wood is one of the materials you can use for your hutches. Build your hutches all the same size, approximately 36 inches wide x 24 inches

deep x 18 inches high. If you build them all the same size they will be easy to arrange and this size is large enough for a doe and litter, a buck or young juniors. Standard one inch thick lumber is a good size to use. Make solid wood floors and use straw, hay, ground corn cobs or any other form of bedding available. The door on the hutch should be full size and covered with one half or five eighths inch mesh screen.

Buy feed and water crocks at your feed store. Always keep a few extra crocks on hand for does with litters and in case you break some.

You will need a nest box for each breeding doe. Apple or pear boxes from your food store make good nest boxes. If you are unable to get any of these boxes you can make them. Ten inches wide x 10 inches high x

16 inches long. Leave the top side open.

Buying Your Rabbits

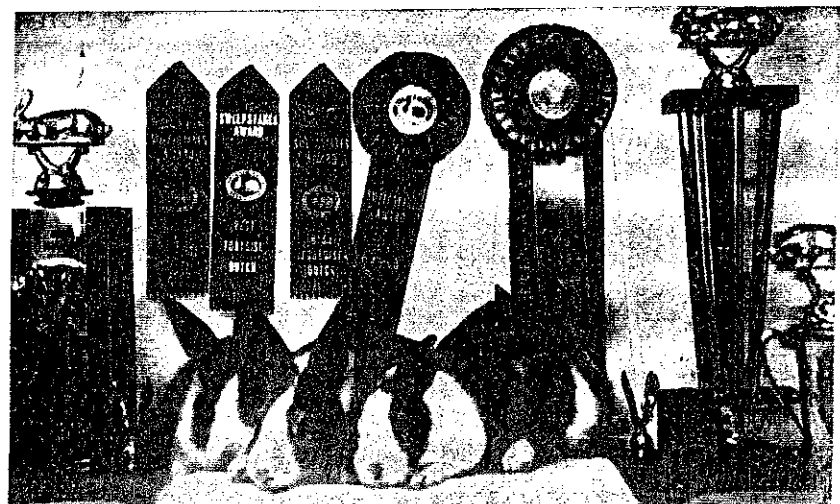
When you write to different breeders for their price list and information, be sure you tell them exactly what you want. Don't just write "How much are your rabbits?" A letter like this is very discouraging to the breeder who has spent his time and effort developing his strain. Not only should you make it clear as to what you want but also you should ask the breeder for three references from people he has sold rabbits to recently. Write to these people and ask about the rabbits that were shipped to them and were they what they ordered? Did they have trouble getting the pedigree papers and were they filled out completely? If you are writing to a well known reliable breeder you may overlook the references.

Do not expect to get good rabbits cheap. A trio will cost you from \$35 to \$150 depending on the type, color, fur, markings and pedigree.

Be ready for your rabbits when they arrive. Have clean bedding, food and water in your hutches.

Check each rabbit carefully, making sure they are what you paid for and that they appear to be in good condition and health. Check the toe nails on all four feet, make sure that there are no toe nails missing. Check the eyes for eye spots. Check the ears for ear canker. Check for cow hocks. Check for broken teeth and buck or

wolf teeth. Check both sexes for apparent vent infection. Check the bucks to make sure they have both testicles.

When you are satisfied that your rabbits are just what you ordered and in good condition, put them in their new hutches and leave them alone, don't handle them anymore than you have to for a week or so until they get used to you and their new home.

Write the breeder, informing him that you have received your rabbits. Tell him what you think of them and offer him your name for reference for his future sales.

Feeding And Breeding

Plan to feed your rabbits at the same time every day. The best time is from 4 p. m. to 6 p. m. Rabbits must have clean water at all times. Don't switch from one feed to another, pick one brand and don't change. Do not over feed your rabbits. Most Dutch require two to four ounces of feed a day, bred does and does with litters about four to six ounces and up depending on the size and age of the litter. There are a number of rabbit feeds on the market today and one is as good as the other.

When your does and bucks are four and one half to five months old they should be ready to breed. Always take the doe to the buck's hutch for mating. As soon as the buck and doe have mated return the doe to her hutch. One mating is all that is required normally. Never use the same buck more than once a day or twice a week. If your doe is bred she will have her litter in about 31 days.

On the 25th day, after she has been bred, put the nest box in one corner of the hutch. Put straw in the box and straw on the floor of the hutch. The doe will pick up the straw and put it in the nest box and build her nest. Some does will build their nest as soon as you put the nest box in the hutch. One mating is all that is re-

fore the litter is born and still others may not build their nest until after the litter is born. Some does will not use the nest box but prefer to build their nest on the hutch floor. If the doe builds her nest on the floor you can move it and the litter into the nest box when the young are about five days old.

When the young come out of the nest box at two and one half to three weeks, you will have to increase the amount of food and add an extra water crock.

When the young are seven to eight weeks old, it is time to take them away from the mother. After a two week rest the doe should be bred again. It is a good idea to sex the young when you take them from the mother and put them into separate hutches.

Buy yourself a line breeding chart and use it. J. C. Fehr's is one of the best and can be bought for about 60 cents.

Remember—clean hutches, clean feed, clean water. These three things are a must for good healthy rabbits.

Showing Your Rabbits And Selling Stock

Never take rabbits to a show that are not in top condition. If you do you will be putting other breeders stock in danger. From time to time you may have stock you wish to sell. Winning at the shows is the best advertisement you can buy. If you have good stock to sell and are honest with your buyers, you will soon develop a reputation and will have no trouble selling your stock.

If you have enough stock to sell it will pay you to advertise in a national magazine and the Dutch Reporter.

Books, Magazines And Clubs

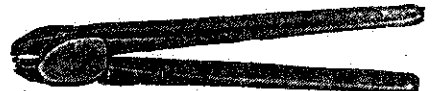
There are a number of good rabbit books on the market today. One of the best is Domestic Rabbit Pro-

duction by George S. Templeton. As for magazines there are a number of very good ones available. The National Rabbit Raiser is very good. You should join the American Rabbit Breeders association and the American Dutch club (or the specialty club of your breed.) From these clubs you will receive guide books and many other benefits otherwise denied to you. There may be a local club in your area. If there is, join it also.

CALIFORNIA DUTCH BREEDERS DO WELL AT ARBA CONVENTION!

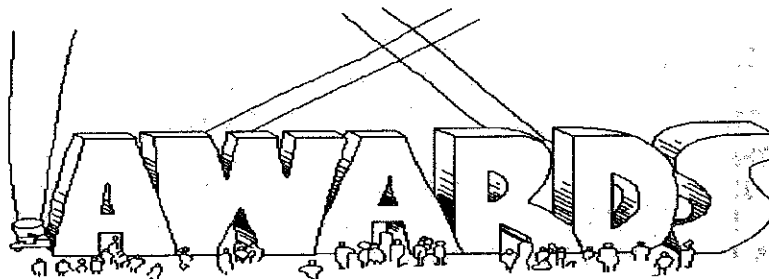

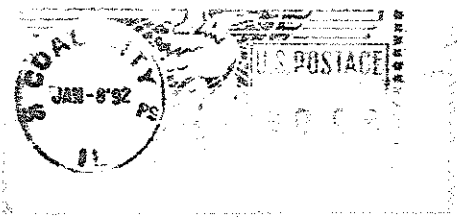
