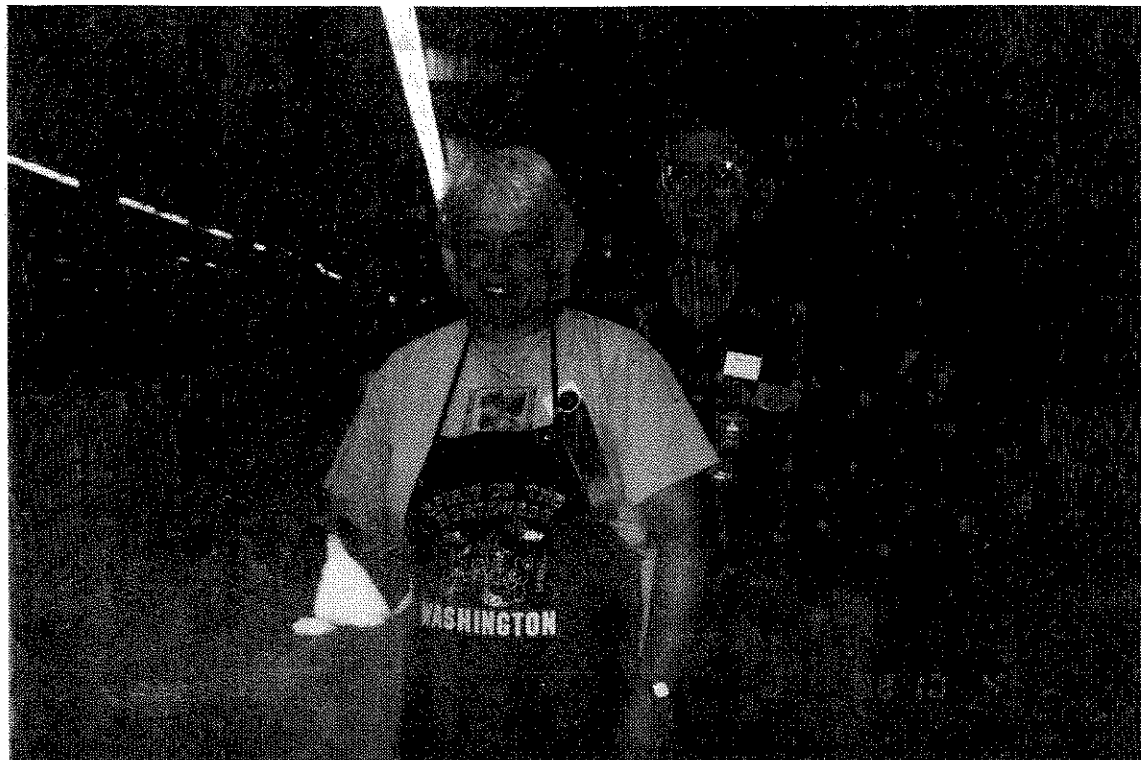

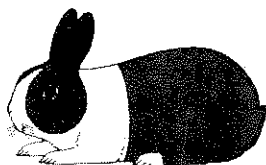

President's MESSAGE

Thanks should go to those who put in all of the effort in hosting the ARBA Convention. I heard the show went well. Congratulations go to Jim and Fran Schettler for their BOB and to Don Johnston for BOS. Congrats also go to the youth winners (my report on the youth winners was not complete). It takes much work to raise good Dutch, and even more work to host one of these shows.

The computer program for our sweepstakes contest, is progressing. We're planning to begin using this for the next sweepstakes year. Our Sweepstakes contests will include our original contest, variety sweepstakes, and Dutch rabbit of the year. This program will also print the show reports which will lessen the burden on our sweepstakes chairman. We have more than 1400 shows per year, so this is a large job.

The Ohio State Dutch Fall Show was held Nov. 8, with a record entry. We weren't expecting that many, but we had an even 200 entered in open, and 106 in youth. All of the exhibitors were from Ohio except for one. Congrats to Bob Hessick who was the big winner in open, and Cody & Danny Lape in youth.

We had a large number of votes cast this year. 183 ballots were received and counted, the most in several years. How about some competition for the offices that expire next year. We had one office which did not have anyone running in District three. I will be appointing a member of that District to fill the vacant office, with

board approval, before the end of the year.

We have a couple of different people who are going to be heading up the development of the next guidebook. Terri Bullis and Shelly Thompson have agreed to solicit articles and plan the layout of the next issue.

We've made several changes in the last couple of years. What ideas do you have that you believe the Dutch Club should take into consideration? Drop a note to one of the Directors or myself with your ideas. We do need articles for the DR. Write one on the topic of the issue, or on whatever you would like, and submit those to the DR editor.

One item that might be of interest. It is quite different being behind the judges table evaluating the classes. It is amazing how many quiet comments are made between exhibitors (in all breeds) that the judge can't hear, that the judge really— can hear. I have spoken to fellow exhibitors when I have been showing, thinking it is out of earshot of the judge. Well, maybe it wasn't.

Ohio has not expressed interest in the 2002 NDS as so mentioned in the General membership meeting minutes. We are interested in 2004. We could hold one in Ohio before 2004 if we have no other bids from clubs wishing to host the show.

Brave the cold weather to care and work with your Dutch this winter. Those extra hours will be well worth it in the long run.

BREEDING TORTS FOR COLOR

by *Kevin Hooper*

There is no real secret to breeding nicely colored torts. Torts are a shaded animal and will always vary in color from animal to animal. Our standard calls for bright orange over the back and smokey-blue shadings. Your shade of orange will vary as will your shading color. There is no doubt that our tort, when it has the correct color, is the most attractive tort color among the breeds. The reason for this is our bright orange, if we can get it.

You should breed torts to torts for the best, most consistent tort color. You will still get some dark, and some light torts. The torts which are not quite the right color, can still be used, providing they are good in all other aspects.

You will find that torts **GENERALLY** darken as they get older. Therefore the torts which are light at four weeks of age, will generally have the better color.

I have been working on the Gold Dutch, as many of you know. The reason for this, is too help the orange color in our torts. I AM NOT CON-

VINCED THAT THIS WILL HAPPEN-YET. I have a couple of pictures of golds from the United Kingdom, known as yellows there, which are a bright pumpkin orange. I am at least a few generations away from that bright orange. But, if we can take that bright orange, and put our smokey blue shadings on them, then wow, awesome tort color. This is the reason that I am working with the golds, to help improve our breed. I have a couple of torts out of a Gold/tort cross, that have been showing very well, and have good tort color. They showed up while I was trying for golds.

LOVING OR LEAVING THOSE DUTCH

Been in Dutch for 5 or more years? Have you noticed how the Dutch breeders you started showing against are still showing their Dutch? Have you noticed that some of them have been breeding and showing Dutch for 20 - 30 - or 40 years or more? Have you noticed that they either only raise and show Dutch or Dutch and one other breed? **HAVE YOU NOTICED THAT BREEDERS WHO RAISE BREEDS OTHER THAN DUTCH SHOW FOR A FEW YEARS AND THEN DISAPPEAR?**

Breeding Dutch rabbits is not the easiest breed to work with. Lets face it, markings are basically like playing the lottery. Even a proven pair may throw a fantastic litter one time and nothing but junk another.

We have all experienced a slump where we could not produce a good Dutch. Normally this slump is six months to a year. Drawing close to that year's end, Dutch breeders will profess to be on the edge of "getting out of Dutch". Then, along comes a "dandy", a show winner, the outstanding animal to lead your Dutch herd back into competition. It feels so good, just to be able to show again with your friends and have respectable rabbits on the show table. Now this does not mean you win every time, only that your near the top.

Why do Dutch breeders remain true to their Dutch? I have always said Dutch are like "black olives". Either you love them or they just make you sick! You have to be a persistent person, one that does not give up easily. You have to enjoy a challenge. You have to have the patience of a saint. And you have to enjoy being with other Dutch breeders and talking "Dutch".

Dutch breeders are the very best folks in the world. Never have I seen a Dutch breeder in a slump where other Dutch breeders did not give up some of their stock to get their friends herd back on the right track. It's not about money. It's about seeing your competition do well. It's about seeing them back on the show table. It's about having a friend to compare Dutch notes with.

Dutch breeders stay in Dutch because they love their Dutch rabbits but most of all they love their Dutch friends. They are family!

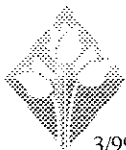

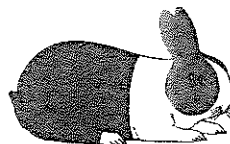

FRECKLES IN THE DUTCH BREED

by Kevin Hooper

There has been a debate that has come up the last several years regarding the freckles or flesh spots in or on the nose or mouth of our Dutch. I had never seen one in my Dutch until 1993. That is not because I hadn't looked, or just hadn't seen them. They had not been there. When I saw the first one, it was easy to see, and I found no other freckles in my other Dutch. I now see it on occasion, and I can trace where it has come from-
about six to seven generations back.

I had a buck and a doe which both turned out having obvious freckles. I bred these two together to determine how this trait is passed to the offspring. I was hoping the entire litter would have freckles since both parents had them. This would mean that to get this out of the herd, you would simply cull any that had freckles. The offspring had no freckles! I have bred two Dutch which didn't have freckles, and one or more of the offspring have had freckles. I have had a certain buck and doe which produced a baby or two which had freckles in one breeding and no freckles in the next two breedings.

The point here is that this is not a trait that is easy to eliminate. Yet it may leave as quietly as it arrived. If these re showing up, try to cull out the common animal that seems to be the source. I know this isn't always easy as it may be your top producing animal, but it is wise in the long run.

I have seen several freckles in Dutch since I received my judges license. The standard says that it is a DQ if it can be seen in its' natural pose or during the sequence of examination. You don't have to look hard to see them, so don't blame the judge if they DQ one for a visible freckle.

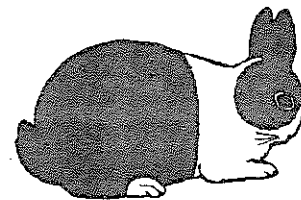

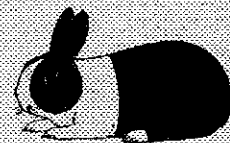

NATIONAL DUTCH SHOW ROYALTY CONTEST GUIDELINES

Divisions: King & Queen 15-18
Duke & Duchess 12-14
Prince & Princess 9-11
Lord & Lady 8 & under

The NDS Royalty Contest is open to any youth member of the ADRC under the age of 19. Age shall be determined as participant's age as of the last day of the NDS. It is not required to have rabbits entered in the NDS to compete in Royalty. All participants shall be required to check in and submit written application by 10:00 PM on Friday. The test, interview, judging and showmanship contests will take place Saturday morning and awards will be

presented at the banquet on Saturday evening.

The winner of the royalty contest shall be the person with the highest overall score from the following areas:

- Written Application
- Written Test
- Oral Interview
- Judging
- Showmanship

Scoring shall be done as follows:

WRITTEN APPLICATION

- A. Purpose Max. 40 pts.
 - B. Size & Scope Max. 20 pts.
 - C. Management Max. 40 pts.
 - D. Achievement Max. 40 pts.
 - E. Leadership Max. 40 pts.
 - F. Goals & Plans for Future Max. 40 pts.
 - G. Clarity, Neatness & Thoroughness Max. 30 pts.
- Total points possible 250 pts.**

Participants shall be required to give name, address, phone number, birthdate, ADRC membership number, and submit a photograph with name and age division written on the back. Questions for the written application shall correspond to those of the ARBA Royalty Contest but shall be specific to the Dutch breed. A list of questions should be published in the October-November-December issue of the Dutch Reporter. These should be neatly written or typed on the applicants own paper. The written application shall be scored by two different judges and the two scores averaged to determine the final score.

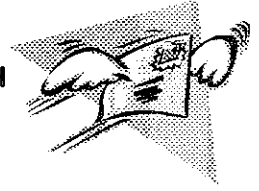
WRITTEN TEST (max. 200 pts.)

The questions for the test shall be taken from the ADRC Guidebook, the most updated version of the ADRC Constitution and By-Laws, the current Dutch Standard, and from general rabbit raising articles in the ARBA Guidebook.

ORAL INTERVIEW (max. 250 pts.)

- A. Background & Experience Max. 50 pts.
- B. Personal Contribution to Industry Max. 50 pts.

- C. Achievements & Leadership Max. 50 pts.
 - D. Attitude (voice & attitude) Max. 50 pts.
 - E. Clarity in giving information Max. 40 pts.
 - F. Appearance of Contestant Max. 10 pts.
- Total points possible 250 pts.**

Questions shall allow participant to talk about rabbit project experience and give information in relation to scoring criteria A, B, and C. The interview should take place before two judges. Their scores will be averaged to determine the final score. *NOTE:* Contestants are to be dressed neatly and appropriately for a rabbit show.

JUDGING & HANDLING (max. 150 pts.)

Each participant shall place two classes of Dutch rabbits. Their scores shall be compared to those of the ARBA Judge officially placing the class (max. 100 pts). Classes shall consist of four rabbits and no more than one disqualified rabbit may be placed in any class. Participants shall be given a seven minute time limit for each class. In addition, each contestant shall be given a handling score (max. 50 pts.). For the Lord and Lady age group, an ID contest involving all 6 varieties may be substituted for Judging. In this case, the handling score will be dropped and score will be taken as a percentage of varieties correctly names.

SHOWMANSHIP (max. 200 pts.)

Since there are many different methods of showmanship, a sample score sheet and explanation of the showmanship process to be used printed along with the questions for the written application.

JUDGING AND SHOWMANSHIP CONTESTS

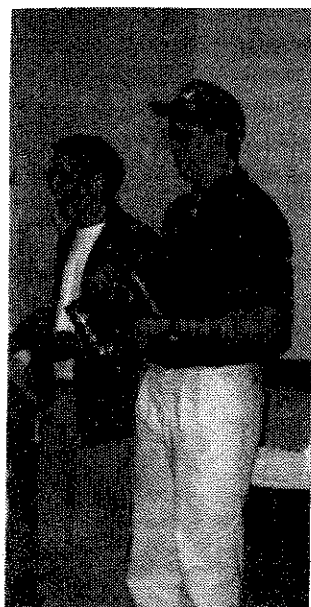
Participants in the Royalty contest are automatically entered in Judging and Showmanship contests, however any youth may participate in these contests without entering Royalty. Awards shall be given to the two top placing youth in each age division as listed above.

ART & CRAFT CONTESTS

The sponsoring and guidelines of any arts and crafts contests shall be left to the discretion of the host club.

1998 ARBA Convention , ADRC Board meeting minutes 10/05/98 Portland, OR

The American Dutch Rabbit Club Board meeting was called to order by Fran Schettler at 8:10 AM, October 5, 1998 in the ADRC booth at Portland, Oregon. Board members answering roll call were: Secretary Bengtson, Directors Barnes, Schettler, Preede, & Carlton. A Motion by Director Carlton, seconded by director Preede to dispense with the reading of the minutes since they had been printed in the Dutch Reporter carried.

OFFICERS REPORTS:

Director Carlton indicates light action in his area, but says they are seeing more Dutch than in the recent past. He says Maria Garcia has been burning up the competition in the southwest. Many breeders in the southwest are using Dutch does as nurse mothers.

Director Barnes spent a hot summer. Her area had just a few shows with youth members growing up and moving on, the youth shows are smaller. Director Barnes would like to see the NDS in Kansas again in 2001.

Director Preede has attended some really good shows in the northeast. They are enjoying some new breeders and a lot of good youth participation, and although it is early in the season it looks like a good one.

Secretary Bengtson reports stable membership numbers, increased sanction numbers and is looking for a good response from ADRC members for the 1999 NDS in Oshkosh, Wisconsin

Director Schettler announced new Dutch clubs in California. Covering the South Oregon and North & NE California territory. The California Dutch Rabbit Club is inactive due to political disturbances. Numbers are pretty good in central California - but are down overall.

REPORTS OF COMMITTEES:

Standards committee presented no report, and directors voiced concerns about proposed changes. The directors feel that the proposed changes need more consideration. It was suggest that some effort be made to educate judges on the subject of "judging dutch". Director Preede will contact Eric Mixdorf, the chairman of the Standards committee. A question of deadlines for ARBA standards

committee needs was addressed. Director Preede and Standards committee member Erik Bengtson are asked to present the work of the Standards committee to date to the members at the membership meeting on Monday.

Youth Royalty guidelines as presented by the committee have been well received. They will be printed in the Dutch Reporter for review and feed back by and from the general membership. They will remain unfinished until after the 1999 National Dutch Show.

Election committee presented no report as yet, however member response has been GOOD.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

1. Chairman of the Guidebook committee is ill and will not be able to fulfill his responsibilities. With a due date of 2001 we are in need of a new chairperson. It was suggested that the opening be presented in the DR along with a request for interested volunteers.

2. The ADRC board is still waiting for a formal bid from the NE Dutch fanciers for the 2000 National Dutch Show. Director Preede was asked to work with them to develop the paperwork for the bid.

3. Treasurers report shows the treasury down about \$2000, with the membership pins paid for (\$1505.00) and \$600 deposit on Sweepstakes program. We will owe another \$600 on that program upon completion, and have no other outstanding bills.

4. Sweepstakes program in progressing. With the donated computer and its' upgrade, the SS chairman should be able to conduct the regular SS contest, along with a variety SS contest and rabbit of the year and also print Dutch Reporter reports.

NEW BUSINESS:

1. Discussion of the ADRC Sec's computer ended with a motion by Director Carlton, seconded by Director Barnes to pursue the purchase of a new system with the necessary attributes for under \$2000. The motion passed with President Hooper and Director Schettler to be on the computer committee. It was the feeling of the board members that a laptop would be desirable, as it would allow the secretary to bring ADRC files to the shows.

2. The Kansas Dutch Club indicates interest in the 2001 NDS. No formal bid was received.

3. Discussion of Rabbit of the Year ended with Director Carlton making a motion and Directors Preede and Barnes seconding that we have a rabbit of the year contest as soon as possible. The motion carried.

4. Mention of a NDS committee to review NDS rules. No action.

5. Discussion of youth judging at ARBA Conventions has always been a concern. Directors Carlton and Barnes were asked to investigate the judging in Oregon. Director Carlton is offering \$50, to help upgrade the quality of youth ARBA convention judges.

6. Discussion of money available to ARBA Convention awards followed. The ADRC offers \$300 for each ARBA convention with \$150 going to youth and \$150 going to open awards. The banquet hat collection is also included. The hat collection in Madison was \$208, so \$508 was available for 1998 Convention awards. Additional monies are usually donated by exhibitors.

ADJOURNMENT:

A motion by Director Barnes, seconded by Director Carlton that the meeting be adjourned was passed. The meeting was adjourned.

National Dutch Show - 2000 in the east. 2001 in Kansas, 2002 in Ohio. (No official bids have been received)

Discussion of **Rabbit of the Year**, with approval of members in attendance.

Discussion of **specials** - note that show committee is \$280 short in specials donations.

Youth judging again discussed.

Letter to be sent to Kentucky to see if anything can be done about improving the judging at the 1999 convention.

ADJOURNMENT:

Motion by director Carlton, seconded by Wayne MacKinnon to adjourn the meeting was carried. The meeting was adjourned.

After adjournment Wayne MacKinnon made a motion, Terry Bullis seconded that the ADRC pay the shortfall from ADRC funds. A discussion followed. The motion passed with 5 members against and the majority for.

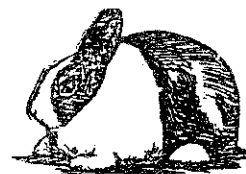

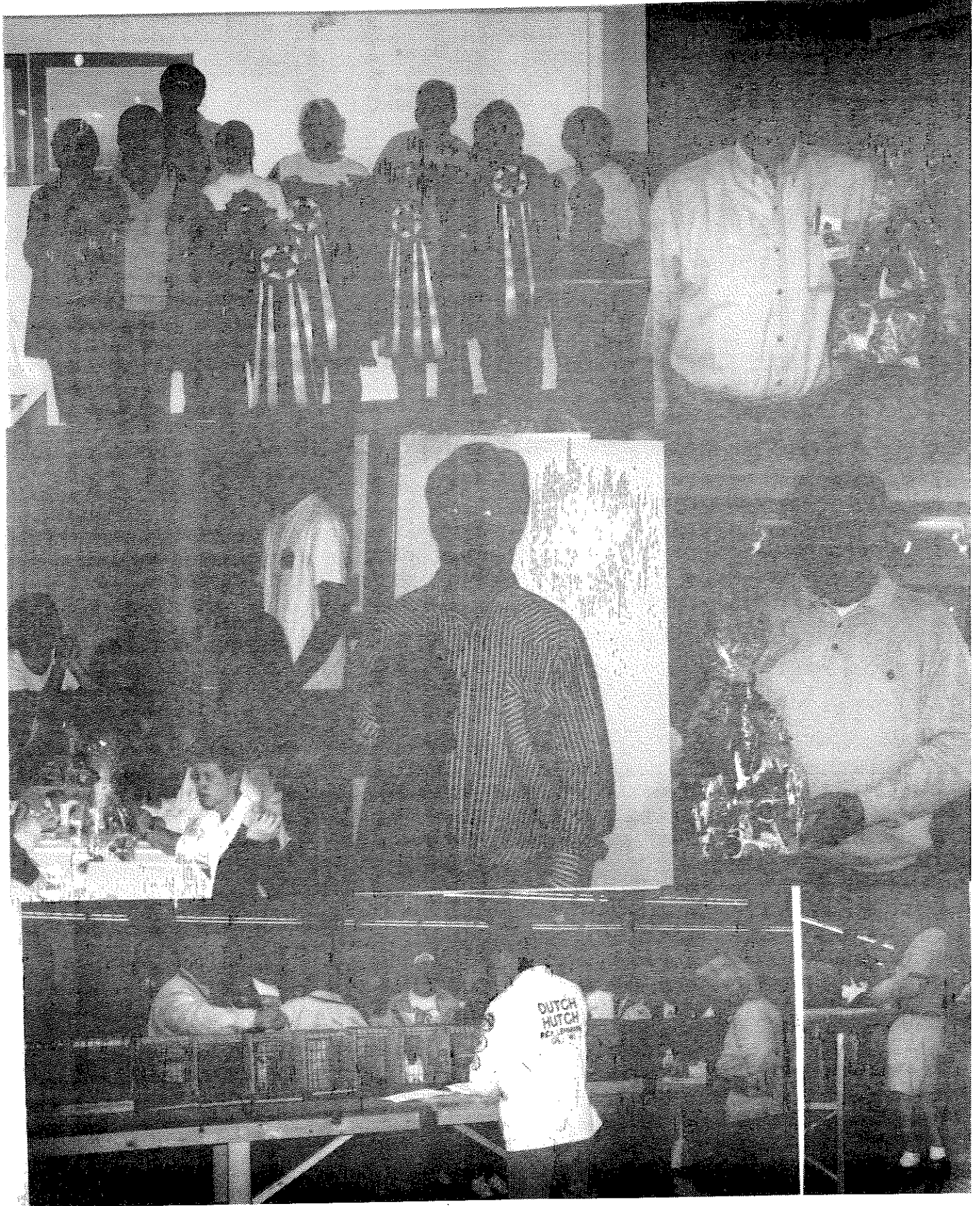

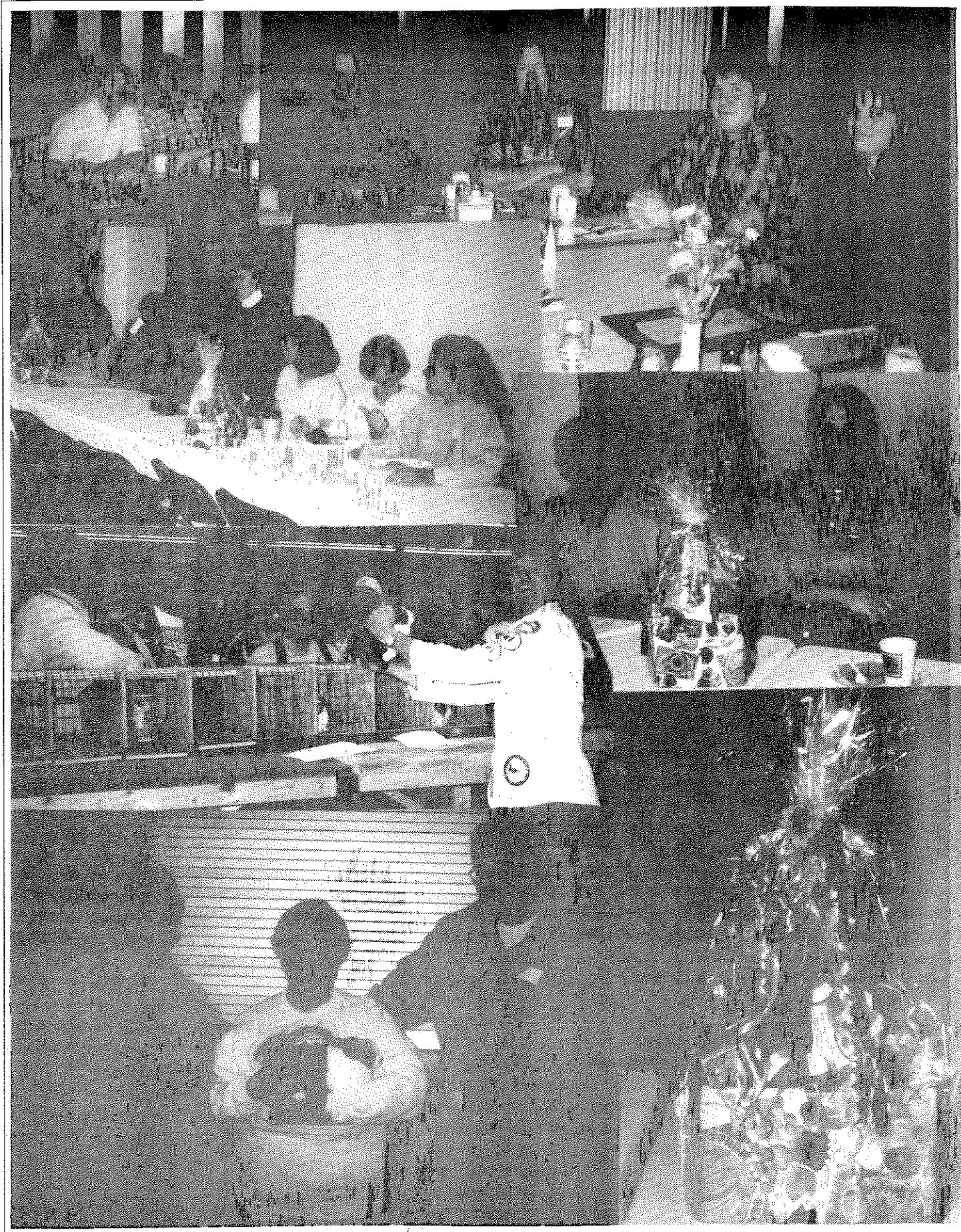

ARBA CONVENTION

The 1998 ARBA Convention was certainly one of the best ARBA Conventions that we have attended. The show room was very nice, well laid out with nice wide aisles and good cooping. Jill Dobson and her crew did an excellent job running the Dutch breed as well.

Jim and I were certainly very pleased and surprised to win Best of Breed. We were very happy with Best Black and Best and Best Opp Chocolate. The black junior doe that won for us was an animal that we didn't even know we had as of the original Convention entry dates. I culled the litter that she was in out just before the show confirmations came back, and was really surprised to find an animal that young with excellent fur, great condition and enough size and type to enter. Although we usually enter national level shows by doing extra entries as "place holders", we had not entered a black junior doe. Was I disappointed! Then the show confirms came back with a sticker that said extra entries accepted! I sure did jump on the Email right away to enter that doe. ARBA Convention was, in fact, her first show.

The doe is out of a black and blue cross that has done very well for us. The black dad is a Wayne MacKinnon buck that I bought a few years ago from him. Thanks again Wayne! The blue mom is from our line. Most of the three generation ancestors of this combination are grand champions. This combination of animals has produced at least one grand champion in every litter as well as some Best in Shows and Best Reserve in Shows. It sure is nice when you find a pair of animals that work that well together consistently. Interestingly, we had a couple of full sisters of the blue doe that, when bred to the same black buck, didn't produce anything of merit. Funny how these things work out.

Thank you to everyone who has sent us their congratulations, and thanks also to those of you who said you really thought our chocolate junior buck should have been Best. We would have been very pleased if he had won as well, as he is a very nice animal too.

If there is one bit of advice that I could pass on to everyone, it would be that we have found that it is really hard to beat a prime young junior animal. They just seem to have that extra "freshness" that makes them stand out. Many breeders breed for a 5 month old junior at nationals. In some cases, a 5 month old has already lost some of its "freshness" and may well be in a transitional coat. Our two biggest wins now have been with 3 to 4 month olds. 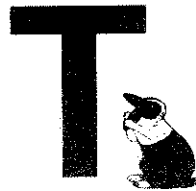
